

Internal Assessment Moderation Criteria 2009

1. The basis of the moderation of Internal Assessment will be average marks of Internal Assessment for the particular paper for all the colleges of the University. Also, the University and College averages in the respective paper will be calculated excluding the candidates who were awarded zero IA marks in the respective paper.
2. No moderation will be undertaken if college average in a particular subject is within a range of University average + - 12 ½ % of the maximum marks in Internal Assessment for that subject.
3. In out-lier cases beyond the range mentioned above, the moderation (both upward as well as downward) as per the procedure illustrate below.
4. All exemptions as were implemented last year may be applied this year also.

Illustration:

- Total IA marks for a subject = T
- We compute (For the chosen Subject):
 - Average marks in IA in each college = X
 - Average marks at the University level = Y
- We locate the out-lier cases where
 - X is less than Y-(12.5 % of T)
 - X is more than Y + (12.5 % of T)
- In case of out – lier cases, we moderate the cases at the college level by:
 - Adding Y- (12.5 % of T) – X in case of X is less than Y – (12.5 % of T)
 - Subtracting X-Y in case of X is more than Y + (12.5 % of T)marks to / from the marks of each student in that College (Rounded off to the nearest Whole Number)
