SHIVAJI COLLEGE

Shivaji College is a premier educational institution, accredited with grade 'A' by NAAC. It was ranked as one of the top 10 science colleges of the country in a survey conducted by India Today in 2017. Shivaji College, a constituent College of University of Delhi, is governed by the Delhi Administration. It is a co-educational institution offering



various courses in Humanities, Science, and Commerce at undergraduate and postgraduate levels. The College has completed 58 years in the area of education. Shivaji College was founded in 1961 by the renowned social activist and farmer-leader, Honourable Dr. Panjab Rao Deshmukh, then Union Minister for Agriculture, to meet the needs and ideals of higher education in a predominantly agrarian area. Since its inception in a small structure in rural Delhi with borrowed science laboratories, the College has come a long way in 2020 with a campus spread over an area of 10 acres, used for academic purposes, residential complex and sports ground. The total built area of the teaching and administrative blocks is 10,002 sq. metres. There are 46 lecture rooms, most of which have multimedia projection facilities. In addition, there are 6 tutorial rooms and 14 science laboratories. There are 4 computer laboratories with all the required software. In addition, a new seven storey building—the Jijabai Academic Block—is under construction, and will add new seminar halls, laboratories and classrooms.

The college offers twenty undergraduate courses in Science, Commerce and Humanities, a self-financing course in Bachelors in Business Economics, three post-graduate courses, and an add-on course in German. The College has an energetic and vibrant faculty that encourages students to go beyond textbooks and acquire experiences that will enable them to become culturally sensitive and socially responsible individuals. Several senior faculty members supervise Ph.D. scholars registered with University of Delhi, while some engage in UGC-sponsored major and minor research projects. Some students of the college frequently emerge as rank-holders in the University examinations and many are placed for internships in prestigious organisations annually. We aim towards holistic development of students, thereby nurturing them in a way that they contribute to the well-being of society and nation. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell of the college ensures quality teaching and monitors the progress of students.

PMMMNMTT AND MHRD

The Ministry of Human Resource Development (MHRD) launched the Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission on Teachers and Teaching (PMMMNMTT) in 2017. One of the main objectives of this mission is to facilitate teacher training by constituting Teaching Learning Centers in various institutions of higher education in our country. The Teaching Learning Centers (TLCs) are mandated to promote on a continuous basis the learning of new pedagogical practices, methodology of forming discipline-specific curricula and creating new learning materials (including e-content) for use by the teachers in colleges and postgraduate departments. It is envisioned that the TLCs will accelerate the teaching-learning process by encouraging independent critical and creative thinking and facilitating research for subject-specific growth.

The TLCs will assist the faculty in capacity building for curriculum designing, scientific assessment and evaluation and the development of innovative academic programs to strengthen the inclusive nature of higher education. The TLCs are also encouraged to reach out to teachers teaching in regionally disadvantaged locations. The Pandit Madan Mohan Malaviya National Mission emphasizes the need to change the role and workings of a teacher from a mere disseminator of information and knowledge to the one who helps students to develop critical, analytical skills, capabilities to generate information, the ability to reason and to empower themselves through open sources and globally oriented digitalized self-learning processes. The focus is not only on 'what is taught' but also importantly, to 'the way it is taught,' in an effort to develop and enhance individual education, that will eventually go on to define the manner in which the future generations will work and live.

The Teaching Learning Centers offer Faculty Induction Programs (FIPs) for newly recruited faculty and Faculty Development Programs (FDPs) for teachers with experience who wish to update their field of knowledge, expertise and skill with the latest available research, resources and technology. In the FDPs, special emphasis is given to inter and cross-disciplinary methodologies of study. Currently, the teaching fraternity is missing their lively and interactive classrooms due to COVID-19 Pandemic. To address the present situation, the University Grants Commission (UGC) has intensified its efforts to have a strong virtual engagement with the students through email/WhatsApp and hosting lectures using Google Class Room and other video-conferencing platforms.

Keeping in view the immense benefits and reach of online courses in the present academic set-up, Shivaji College under the aegis of IQAC in collaboration with the Teaching Learning Centre at Ramanujan College, University of Delhi plans to offer a One Week Faculty Development Programme on “ICT ENHANCED TEACHING LEARNING AND CREATING MOOCs” for faculty members and research scholars of higher education in the country from 18th August – 25th August, 2020.

RAMANUJAN COLLEGE

Ramanujan College is University of Delhi College located in the well-known area of Kalkaji, near Nehru Place in South Delhi.
