INSTRUCTIONS

Applicants appearing for the Entrance Examination of Undergraduate Courses based on Entrance Examination Only (2016-2017), must check the following instructions carefully:

- (A) Instructions given on the Admit Cards
- (B) General Instructions, in addition to instructions given in Section "A"
- (C) Department/College Specific Instructions, if any, in addition to instructions given in Sections "A" and "B".

(A) INSTRUCTIONS GIVEN ON THE ADMIT CARDS

1. The Applicant is being allowed to appear in the Entrance Examination, subject to fulfillment of the eligibility conditions and verification of applicant's documents after declaration of result of the Entrance Examination. Merely qualifying the entrance examination does not guarantee admission of the applicant to the course. The admission of the applicant will be considered in accordance with the University rules.
2. Along with the printed copy of this Admit card, please bring a valid ID proof (in original) and a passport size photograph.
3. Please use only last five digits of the Roll number (as printed on the admit card) for your OMR sheet, e.g. for roll no. "164512345", the roll no. for the OMR sheet will be 12345.
4. **The applicant must bring Black/Blue Ball Point Pen for filling OMR Sheet. Use of Pencil, Pilot Pen, Fountain Pen is strictly prohibited.**
5. **Electronic and Communication Devices like Cellular Phone/Pager etc. and Textual materials are strictly prohibited in the examination premises. No whitener/eraser/blade is allowed for changing answers. Eatable items and water bottles are not allowed inside examination premises.**
6. The candidates are advised to visit the University Website, i.e. www.du.ac.in for Department / College specific guidelines, if any. [Given below in Section "C"]

(B) GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

1. Applicants are required to retain Admit Card for production at the time of collection of admission slip, if selected for admission.
2. Applicants will not be allowed to enter into the Examination Hall after the scheduled time of commencement of Examination.

3. Applicants will be required to remain seated for the entire duration of the entrance examination.
4. No applicant shall be allowed to leave the Examination Hall before the conclusion of the test and without handing over the Answer Sheet to the Invigilator concerned.
5. All Visually Disabled (VD) and Other than Visually Disabled (OVD) Applicants (as per University Guidelines vide letter dated 28.01.2014 at www.du.ac.in) who need scribe/writer must bring their original Disability Certificate issued by Government hospital along with a photocopy.
6. Scribes/writers assisting the Visually Disabled (VD) and Other than Visually Disabled (OVD) must bring original and a copy of their valid identity proof.

(C) DEPARTMENT/COLLEGE SPECIFIC INSTRUCTIONS

I: B.Sc. (Physical Education, Health Education & Sports)

1. The Applicants, **who have qualified** on the basis of written test, must ensure that they have filled up the additional forms, namely Entrance Test card for B.Sc. (PEHE&S) 2016-17, & Medical Fitness Certificate form, and have submitted the same in the Indira Gandhi Institute of Physical Education & Sports Sciences along with the copy of online admission form.
2. The qualified Applicants on the basis of written examination must check the schedule of Admission process after written examination and they must appear in other components of examination as displayed in the schedule.
3. The Applicants who have not submitted these additional forms must submit the same through email (igipess.delhiuniversity@gmail.com) on or before 27th June, 2016.

II: B.Tech. (Information Technology and Mathematical Innovations); Cluster Innovation Centre, University of Delhi, Delhi

1. The question paper shall have 100 questions. For each correct answer a student will get + 4 marks. There will -1 for every incorrect answer. No marks will be deducted for an unattempted question.
2. The result of Entrance Test will be posted on the official website of University of Delhi (<http://du.ac.in>) and Cluster Innovation Centre (<http://ducic.ac.in>) on or before 4th July 2016. The students are instructed to visit the website for the result. No separate communication will be sent in this regard.
