The counselling is strictly for those applicants who fall within the range of marks as notified above. The candidates are required to appear for counselling in person. Applicants are required to bring all the necessary original documents required for LL.B. admissions notified by University, failing which the admission will not be granted. 1. The admission will be strictly on the basis of merit amongst the candidates reporting for admission and the availability of seats in the Centre in their category.

2. The call does not guarantee admission in LLB course as number of applicants called for counseling is more than the available vacant seats in the course.

3. The shortlisted candidates will be allowed to pay the fee online till 10 pm of 14 th October, 2017. No further time will be given to pay fee.

4.If the seats in ST category still remain unfilled, they will be given to those candidates who have appeared in person and submitted their original documents on 3rd October purely on merit basis as per seat conversion rule of Delhi University.
