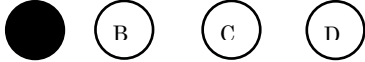


UNIVERSITY OF DELHI
INSTRUCTIONS FOR ENTRANCE EXAMINATION- 2017

1. The applicant is being allowed to appear in the Entrance Examination, subject to fulfillment of the eligibility conditions and verification of applicant's documents after declaration of result of the Entrance Examination. Merely qualifying the entrance examination does not guarantee admission of the applicant to the course. The admission of the applicant will be considered in accordance with the University rules.
2. Reporting time is one hour before the start of examination. Traffic may be heavy on the day of examination. Candidates are advised to reach the centre well in time.
3. Gate of the examination centre will close 15 minutes before the commencement of examination. Entry shall not be allowed under any circumstances after gate is closed.
4. No candidate is allowed to leave the examination hall before the end of examination i.e. 2 hours.
5. Along with the printed copy of Admit card, please bring a valid ID proof (in original) and a passport size photograph.
- 6. Electronic and communication devices like cellular phone / smart electronic gadgets etc. and textual materials are strictly prohibited in the examination centre premises.**
7. No bags are permitted in the exam premises. Smoking, eatables and water bottles are not allowed inside the examination hall.
8. Candidate will not be entertained by any examination centre other than the one allotted.
- 9. Non-programmable calculator is allowed.**
10. Open the seal of the booklet only when instructed to do so (For offline exams). Don't start answering the questions until you are asked to do so.

11. Ensure that there are 50/ 100 questions in the Test Booklet with four responses A, B, C and D. Of them only one is correct as the best answer to the question concerned.
12. There will be **NEGATIVE MARKING** for wrong answer. Each correct answer shall be awarded 4 marks, while **one mark** will be deducted for each wrong answer.
13. Multiple answering of a question will cause the answer to be rejected.
14. The applicant must bring **black/blue ball point pen** for filling the OMR sheet (For offline exams). Use of pencil, ink/jel pen is strictly prohibited.
15. Use only **Black or Blue** Ball pen for darkening the circle completely (for offline exam). For example : 
16. Rough work is to be done only on the rough pages of the Test Booklet and not on the answer (OMR) sheet or any where else.
17. Make sure that you do not possess any pages (Blank or Printed) or any unauthorized material in any form. If such material is found in your possession during the examination, you will be disqualified for admission.
18. If you are found copying / helping others or indulging in unruly behaviour you will be disqualified for admission.
19. At the end of the examination hand over the answer (OMR) sheet to the invigilator (for offline exams).
20. Candidates are allowed to take the Test Booklet (for offline exams) with them.
21. Candidates are advised to contact the Examination Superintendent for submission of representation related to examination, if any.
