**Qualifying Marks for History M.Phil./Ph.D Entrance Examination 2017**

The qualifying marks in the M.Phil/Ph.D Entrance Examinations are as follows :

Category		Marks
General	-	140
OBC/CWD	-	120
SC/ST	-	80
PWD	-	60

These qualifying marks are the minimum marks required to be eligible for the interview. Candidates who qualify in the Entrance Examination will be called for the interview, along with all those candidates who are exempted from the Entrance Examination.

Securing the Qualifying Marks in the Entrance Examinations is not a guarantee for admission, but merely an entitlement to be considered for admission. Admission to the M.Phil & Ph.D programmes shall depend on the interview, the availability of seats in the course, and other requirements and rules as notified in the University's Bulletin of Information.

Those applicants who qualify directly for the interview (Categories II - VI as specified Ordinance VI, including those who have cleared the UGC-NET), will also be interviewed.

Admission for the various categories (OBC/SC/ST/PWD/Others) will be according to the University reservation rules.

The date and time of interviews will be notified shortly.
