### **CRITERIA OF EIGHTH ADMISSION LIST FOR GENERAL/SC/ST/PWD & OBC CATEGORIES**

#### Political Science

Admission Closed for all the Categories (except PWD category : for admission contact the Office.)

#### Hindi

Admission Closed for all the Categories

#### Commerce

General/OBC & SC Categories -Admissions closed

#### For ST & PWD Categories

##### CATEGORY-I

67% marks in aggregate of Commerce stream i.e. Hindi/English and any three of Business Studies, Accounts, Economics & Mathematics

##### CATEGORY-II

69% and above marks in aggregate of Commerce stream (one vocational subject relating to Commerce would be considered).

##### CATEGORY-III

71% marks and above in aggregate for Science & Arts stream (only two vocational subject would be considered).

#### English

General Category closed

#### For OBC Category

73% and above marks in aggregate including English for any stream

Note : 5% relaxation to students having studied a second or Elective English paper in Class-XII along with the compulsory English paper.

**For SC (66%), ST (63%), and PWD candidates (65%), from any stream/category.**

## Economics

General Category closed

### For OBC Category

73% and above marks in aggregate with 1 language and any 03 academic subjects (except Physical Education, Fine Arts, Music, Dance & Home Science)

For SC/ST/PWD Categories : 70%, as above category.

## Psychology

General Category closed

For OBC candidates

### CATEGORY I

77% and above marks in aggregate (best of 04 subjects) with one language and any 03 of the following subjects: Economics, Pol. Science, History, Geography, Sociology, Philosophy, Mathematics & Psychology.

### CATEGORY II

79% and above marks in aggregate (with best of 04 subjects) with one language and any three subjects from Science or Commerce stream.

### CATEGORY III

82% and above marks in aggregate with one language and 02 academic subjects and any one of the following subjects : Home Science, Fine Arts, Agriculture, Computer Science, Informatics Practices, Physical Education, Music, Dance, Entrepreneurship.

Note : 01% concession in aggregate for students with minimum 80% marks in Psychology.

For SC/ST/PWD Categories : 76%-78%-81%, as above categories.

## Geography

General, OBC & ST Categories closed

### For SC & PWD Categories :

#### CATEGORY-I (For Humanities, Science & Commerce streams with Geography)

68% and above marks in best of four subjects including Geography (one language, three academic **Or**, two academic plus one of the following subjects i.e. Travel & Tourism, Graphic Design, Fine Arts, Geospatial Technology, Computer Science and Informatics Practices).

#### CATEGORY-II (For Humanities/Science/Commerce without Geography)

71% and above marks in best of four subjects i.e. one language, three academic **Or**, two academic plus one of the following subjects i.e. Travel & Tourism, Graphic Design, Fine Arts, Geospatial Technology, Computer Science and Informatics Practices.

## Mathematics

General & OBC Categories closed

### For SC/ST/PWD Categories :

73% or above in best of 04 academic subjects including Mathematics and one language (Hindi/English).

## Sociology

### CATEGORY-I

83.25% and above marks in aggregate (best of 04 subjects) with one language plus any 03 subjects of the following : Sociology, Economics, Political Science, History, Geography, Mathematics, Psychology, Philosophy, Hindi Elective, English Elective & Other Languages.

### CATEGORY-II

88.25% and above marks in aggregate (best of 04 subjects) with one language plus any 02 academic subjects and any one of the following : Home Science, Fine Arts, Computer Science, Informatics Practices, Physical Education, Web and Multimedia Technology, Music, Dance, Accountancy, Commerce, Entrepreneurship & Business Studies.

### CATEGORY-III

90.25% and above marks in aggregate (best of 04 subjects) with one language and any 03 academic subjects from Science or Commerce stream.

### Note

1. 70% and above marks in English for all the above three categories.
2. 05% concession in aggregate will be given to students who have secured 72% and above marks in Sociology in Class-XII examination for all the above three categories.

**For OBC (67%-72%-73% respectively), SC/ST/OBC/PWD (65%-70%-72% respectively)**

## Journalism

### CATEGORY-I

91.5% and above marks (best of 04 subjects) in academic subjects of Humanities stream -with at least 02 of any of the following subjects : Economics, Political Science, History, Geography, Sociology, Psychology & Philosophy. Minimum 70% marks in English is compulsory.

### CATEGORY-II

92.5% and above marks (best of 04 subjects) in academic subjects of Science stream -with at least 02 of any of the following subjects : Physics, Chemistry, Biology, Mathematics, Engineering Drawing & Computer Science. Minimum 70% marks in English is compulsory.

### CATEGORY-III

93.5% and above marks (best of 04 subjects) in academic subjects of Commerce stream -with at least 02 of any of the following subjects : Mathematics, Economics, Business Studies & Accountancy. Minimum 70% marks in English is compulsory.

### CATEGORY-IV

93.5% and above marks (best of 04 subjects) in 02 academic subjects and any one subject out of the following Fine Arts, Painting, Multimedia, Dance, Music, Creative Writing and Translation Studies. Minimum 70% marks in English is compulsory.

**For SC/ST/OBC/PWD (75-76-76-78% respectively) & English as a subject in Class-XII is compulsory.**

## History

General/SC/ST Category closed

For OBC/PWD Categories :

### CATEGORY I

66% and above marks in Humanities, 60% in History with one language (including English is compulsory) and any 02 of the following subjects: Political Science, Sociology, Anthropology, Psychology, Geography, Economics, Mathematics, and Philosophy.

### CATEGORY II

67% and above marks for students from non-history in Humanities with one language (including English is compulsory) and any 03 of the following subjects: Political Science, Sociology, Anthropology, Psychology, Geography, Economics, Mathematics, and Philosophy.

### CATEGORY III

69% and above marks in Science stream with 01 language (including English is compulsory) and 05 of the following subjects - Physics, Mathematics, Biology, Chemistry, Mechanical Drawing/Engineering Drawing and Computer Science.

### CATEGORY IV

72% and above marks for Commerce stream with 01 language (including English is compulsory) and 03 of the following subjects - Accounts, Mathematics, Business Studies, Economics and Commerce.

### CATEGORY V

82% and above marks with one language (including English is compulsory), one vocational and two academic subjects.

## Philosophy

70% and above marks in aggregate with best four academic subjects (01 language and 03 academic subjects) & 75% and above marks in English.

For OBC- 63% and SC/ST/PWD Categories 60%, as above category & English as a subject in Class XII is compulsory.

## Sanskrit

General/SC/ST Categories closed

For OBC/PWD Categories :

### CATEGORY I

40% and above marks in best of four subjects in Humanities stream and knowledge of Sanskrit is compulsory.

### CATEGORY II

43% and above marks in best of four subjects for Commerce/Science stream and knowledge of Sanskrit is compulsory.
