At the time of admission, the applicants shall be required to produce the following documents in original along with two set of self-attested photocopies (both sides):

- *Class X Board Examination Certificate
- *Class X marks-sheet
- *Class XII marks-sheet
- *Class XII Provisional Certificate
- Character Certificate (**recent**)
- *SC/ST/OBC (Non-Creamy Layer) Certificate (in candidate's own name)
- Transfer Certificate from school/college as well as Migration Certificate from Board/Univ. are required from those students who have passed from outside Delhi
- Photo copy of the Passport (for foreign students only)
- *Two Affidavits (anti-ragging) one from the candidate and one from parent/Guardian

*Documents are compulsory at the time of admission

Two recent passport-size photograph of the candidate is to be affixed on the Admission Form.

One passport-size photogra

ph of either of the parents should also be affixed on the admission form. For the confirmation of the identity of the parent/guardian, candidate must bring in original as well as photocopy of either voter's I.D. Card/Driving License/Passport of either parent/guardian (for outstation candidates only)

The procedure of admission is printed at the back of the Requisition Form to be obtained from the Admission Committee.

The basis of calculation of %age of marks is as follows or mentioned in the cut-off list.

B.A. Program/B.A. (Hons.)

- (a) The percentage of marks shall be calculated on the basis of four best subjects including one or at the most two languages.
- (b) 8% marks {for B.A. Program courses}/ 10% marks {for B.A. (Hons.) Courses} will be deducted from the marks in the following subject if a candidate includes any of the following subjects among his/her best four subjects.

Informatics Practices, Physical Education, Music, Dance, Entrepreneurship, Environmental Education/Science/Studies, Fashion Studies, Engineering Drawing, Fine Arts, Agriculture and Web & Multimedia Technology or any other vocational subject.

NOTE :

Compartment cases shall be considered on the basis of marks obtained by the candidate in three subjects as per rules already indicated against each course and adding 33% marks in the subject in which he/she has been placed in the compartment. If in this process the candidate reaches the cut-off percentage point, provisional admission shall be granted. However, compartmental cases will not be considered for admission to B.Sc. (Hons.) courses.
