1. The result of the candidates who have applied for M.Phil. and Ph. D Programme and appeared for DUET-2020 is already declared by the NTA and is available on the University website. As per qualifying criteria (50% for Un-reserved and 45% for Reserved Category), rank wise merit list will be uploaded on the University website.
2. The list of the shortlisted candidates and those who have qualified NET/JRF and exempted from the entrance examination will also be uploaded on the University website.
3. The interviews/ presentation shall start from **10.00 a.m.** onwards on the mentioned dates. **The google meet link** will be shared to respective candidate on their Email Id to join the interview/presentation.
