Notice

The Department of Philosophy shall hold **PhD interviews** on 5th, 7th, 8th and 9th January 2021. However, the interviews could be extended beyond these dates.

M. Phil interviews shall be held on 11th, 12th and 13th January 2021.

Interviews shall be held online and the link and timings will be provided to students on the website at least two days in advance. Exact details will be sent to students by email. However if students wish to give their interview in person, please write to the email given below as soon as possible. These will be arranged accordingly and maybe held on dates different from those given above.

The list of students who have qualified for this round of interviews is attached. *

All students who are appearing for the **PhD interview** are required to submit a research proposal.

Candidates could follow the following guidelines while preparing their proposal: The proposal shall be neatly typed and not handwritten; it should be 2000-3000 words in length; the title should be a clear indication of what research is intended to be undertaken; research question/s should be raised identifying the problem/s; the aim of the research may be explained; some light may be thrown on already existing debates; the methodology the student hopes to follow may be mentioned; a short literature review is required; a bibliography should be included listing readings referred to in the proposal and further readings.

The **PhD applicants** will also have to submit a short (strictly one page) abstract of the proposal that states in brief the problem and aim as well as any other aspect they wish to highlight.

M. Phil aspirants shall submit a one-page abstract stating their area of interest and focus of possible research.

The last date of the submission of the proposal and abstract for both M. Phil and PhD is **31st December 2020**.

All required details should be provided and documents should be uploaded to the form.

Both the proposal and abstract should contain the name of the candidate on the top right-hand side. The pages of the proposal should be clearly numbered.
