**URGENT NOTIFICATION**

**Eligible Candidates for M. Phil History Interview**

1. Those applicants whose qualifications fall within Categories C-1 #s II – VI as specified in Ordinance VI, including those who have cleared the UGC-NET are eligible to appear directly for the interview.
2. *ACCORDING TO THE AMENDMENTS TO ORDINANCE VI, VI-A AND VI-B, C-1 (approved by the Executive Council in its meeting held on 01-02.07.2019) REGARDING M.PHIL AND PH.D (AND THE BULLETIN OF INFORMATION FOR M.PHIL AND PH.D ADMISSIONS), ONLY THOSE CANDIDATES WHO SCORED 50% OR ABOVE (100/200) FROM UNRESERVED CATEGORY and 45% (90/200) IN THE ENTRANCE EXAMINATION 2020 ARE ELIGIBLE TO APPEAR FOR THE INTERVIEW.*
3. Candidates appearing for the interview through the entrance examination, a weightage of 70% to the entrance test and 30% to the performance in the interview shall be accorded in the calculation of final marks.
4. Candidates appearing directly for the interview having qualified UGC-NET/JRF etc., would be entirely evaluated (weightage of 100%) on the performance in the interview.

**5. Details Regarding M. Phil Admission:**

- (i) A total of 24 candidates would be admitted to the M.Phil programme during the academic year 2020-21 (excluding the supernumerary seats) as per the statutory provisions.
- (ii) The Department of History reserves the right not to fill up the vacant seats of M.Phil. programme in case of non-availability of suitable candidate/s.
- (iii) The admission list will be prepared in order of merit according to statutory reservation policy.

**6. Details Regarding M. Phil Interview:**

7. All candidates are required to submit the following documents on the designated email id. [duhistory.mphiladmissions@gmail.com](mailto:duhistory.mphiladmissions@gmail.com) by 2<sup>nd</sup> January 2021 (5:00 pm) to become eligible to appear in the interview:
  - (i) A copy of application form, Admit card, NET/JRF certificate and other supporting documents.
  - (ii) All candidates appearing directly or through examination –one copy of writing sample, either an MA term paper or an independently conceptualized research proposal.

(iii) Interviews will be conducted both in Online and Offline modes. The candidates while electronically submitting their research proposal/ writing sample/ term paper and other documents through email should must clearly mention their choice of mode of appearing in the interview. In case the candidate does not mention the choice for the mode of interview, it will be conducted in the online mode only.

8. Appearance in the M.Phil entrance examination/interview is not a guarantee for admission, but merely an entitlement to be considered for admission. Admission to the M.Phil programme shall depend on the quality of the candidate's interview, the availability of seats in the course, and other requirements and rules as notified in the University's Bulletin of Information.
9. Interviews are tentatively scheduled for 05th - 07<sup>th</sup> January, 2021.
