- Author name and affiliation written below the article title.
- Abstracts not exceeding 250-300 words.
- Keywords - 4-5 No.
- Content - 5000- 7000 words including tables, Pictures and References (in APA Style).
- Font Style - Times New Roman,
- Font Size - Content -12, Title -14.
- Spacing - 1.15 spacing in text, title-1.5
- Participant should satisfy the Plagarism and ensure that article is not submitted anywhere else.
- Guidelines for Poster Presentation
Poster should have *The title, contents and the author's information *Organize your poster into subdivisions, e.g., Introduction, Methods, Results, Discussion, Conclusions, and Literature Cited (avoid using too many citations).

- Only selected good quality articles will be published in an edited book with ISBN No.
- Only abstracts are also accepted.
