Shri Raghubeer S. Honi Scholarship

- a. There will be a scholarship to be known as "Shri Raghubeer S. Honi Scholarship" of the value of ₹1000/- per month or the amount earned by the endowment, whichever is less, for ten academic months, to be awarded each year to a economically weaker student of the LL.B. 1<sup>st</sup> year in the University of Delhi.
- b. The scholarship will be awarded to a economically weaker student in the 1<sup>st</sup> year of LL. B. and will be renewed in the 2<sup>nd</sup> year and 3<sup>rd</sup> year, subject to the satisfactory performance of the student in his L.L.B. examinations. Thus, the scholarship will be tenable for a period of 3 years.
- c. If the awardee fails to pass examination of any part of the LL.B., he will not be eligible for renewal of the scholarship for the next year.
- d. The scholarship will be awarded by the University on the recommendation of a Selection Committee, consisting of the following.
  1. The Dean, Faculty of Law
  2. In-charges of the three Law Centers
- e. The students already receiving any scholarship or financial assistance in any form shall not be eligible to be considered for the scholarship.
- f. The amount of the scholarship shall be released to the awardee through the Dean, Faculty of Law on presentation of bills by the awardee and a certificate to the effect that the awardee was not in receipt of any other scholarship/financial assistance from any other source during the said period.
- g. If it should appear at any time during the tenure of the scholarship that the student has failed to make satisfactory progress or has been found guilty of gross misconduct or has been irregular in attendance, it shall, after due warning in writing, be reported by the Dean, Faculty of Law to the University, which may reduce, suspend or withdraw the scholarship.
- h. Any amount of interest earned by the endowment and not spent in any year will be added to the endowment.
