“Dr. (Mrs.) SHOBHANA NAYAR & PROF. D.P. NAYAR SCHOLARSHIP”

1. “There shall be **One** scholarship known as the “Dr. (Mrs.) Shobhana Nayar & Prof. D.P. Nayar Scholarship” to be awarded to a student of B.A. (H) Music Course, of the value of Rs. 3500/- per annum out of the annual income accruing from the endowment of Rs. 2,00,000/- (Rupees Two Lakhs Only) endowed by Sh. Rahul Nayar, S/o Late Dr. (Mrs.) Shobhana Nayar & Prof. D.P. Nayar , 100 Cold Spring Road, A-206 Rocky Hill, CT 06067, U.S.A. in the memory of his parents.
 2. The scholarship shall be awarded to a poor candidate who secures the highest marks in the 12th Standard School Examination and joins the B.A. (H) Music Course.
 3. The scholarship shall be tenable for the duration of the course renewable for 2nd and 3rd year on the basis of satisfactory performance of the awardee.
 4. No student shall be eligible for award of this scholarship if he/she already holds a scholarship awarded by Delhi University or any other University or the Central Government or any state Government or Private Body, other than freeship.
 5. In case a scholar accepts any other scholarship/financial assistance from any other source he/she shall be required to refund the amount received by him/her on this account from the date he/she accepts the other scholarship/financial assistance.
 6. If it should appear at any time during the tenure of the award that the scholar has failed to make satisfactory progress or has been found guilty of gross-misconduct or has been very irregular in attendance he/she shall after due warning in writing, to be reported by the Head of the Institution/Department to the Academic Council who may reduce, suspend or withdraw his/her scholarship.
 7. The scholarships shall be awarded by the Academic Council on the recommendations of the Selection Committee, consisting of the following:-
 1. Dean, Faculty of Music (Chairman)
 2. Head, Department of Music
 3. Two Senior teachers of the Department of Music
 8. The payment of the scholarship amount shall be made to the scholar through the Head of the Institution from May each year on presentation of a bill along with certificate to the effect that during the period covered in the bill/s the scholar was not in receipt of any other scholarship/financial assistance from any other source.
 9. The unutilized amount in any year shall be added to the corpus of the endowment fund.
