**'NAIN SUKH GAUBA AND DEV HUTI GAUBA MEMORIAL
SCHOLARSHIP**

1. There shall be one scholarship^x known as "Nain Sukh Gauba and Dev Huti Gauba Memorial Scholarship" of the value of Rs.500/-p.m.^x to be awarded out of the annual income accruing from the endowment fund of Rs.50,000/- received from Shri Bikram Gauba 46/1, East Patel Nagar, New Delhi.
2. The Scholarship will be awarded to meritorious and needy **female student** whose parents/husband's income including her own income does not exceed to the amount from where it starts attracting income tax, and who joins in the first year of the LL.B. Course in the Campus Law Centre, University of Delhi.
3. The Scholarship shall be tenable for a period of three years renewable yearly on the basis of satisfactory performance of the awardee.
 - a. No student shall be eligible for the award of this scholarship if she already holds a scholarship awarded by the Delhi University or any other University or the Central Government, or any State Government or Private Body, other than Freeship.
 - b. In case any scholar accepts any other scholarship/financial assistance from any other source, she shall be required to refund the amount received by her on this account from the date she accepts the other scholarship/financial assistance.
4. If it should appear at any time during the tenure of the award that the scholar has failed to make satisfactory progress or has been found guilty of gross misconduct or has been irregular in attendance, she shall, after due warning, in writing, be reported by the Principal/Head of the Institution/Department to the Academic Council which may reduce, suspend or withdraw the scholarship.
5. The scholarship shall be awarded by the Academic Council on the recommendations of a Selection Committee constituted as follows:
 1. The Dean, Faculty of Law (Chairman)
 2. Professor-in-charge, Campus Law Centre
 3. Professor-in-charge, Law Centre-I and Professor-in-charge, Law Centre-II
6. The payment of the scholarship amount shall be made to the scholar through the Head of the Institution from May each year on presentation of a bill, a certificate to the effect that during the period covered in the bill, the scholar was not in receipt of any other scholarship/financial assistance from any other source.
7. The unutilized amount in any year shall be added to the corpus of the endowment fund.

** The value of the book grant be at the present accrued annual income on such endowment fund {SC(scholarship) meeting dated 27/1/04 }.
