" DR. O.P. JAIN MEMORIAL SCHOLARSHIP "

" There shall be one scholarship known as 'Dr. O.P. Jain Memorial Scholarship' to be awarded to M.A./M.Sc. Part-II Operational Research student of this University out of the annual income accruing from the endowment fund of Rs.25,000/- (Twenty five thousand only) given by Ms. Kusum Jain(66, Sector 10-A, Chandigarh-160011, wife of late Dr. O.P. Jain)

Value of the scholarship Rs.250/- per month.**

ELIGIBILITY AND CONDITION OF AWARD.

- i) The scholarship will be awarded to the candidate who has secured highest percentage of marks in his/her M.A./M.Sc. Part I in Operational Research of this University and taken admission in the M.A./M.Sc. Part-II in Operational Research of this University. The scholarship will be for a period of one year subject to the condition that the awardee secures 60% or above marks in M.A./M.Sc. Part-I examination. The award will be made each year.
- ii) No. Student shall be eligible for the award of this scholarship.
 - a) In case the student already holds a scholarship awarded by the Delhi University or any other University of the Central Government of any state Government or Private Body, other than freeship.
 - b) In case any scholar accepts any other scholarship/ financial assistance.
- iii) If it should appear at any time during the tenure of the award that the scholar has failed to make satisfactory progress or has been found guilty of gross misconduct or has been irregular in attendance he/she shall, after due warning in writing, be reported by the Principal/Head of the Institution/Department to the Academic Council which may reduce suspend or withdraw the scholarship.
- iv) Application for the scholarship in the prescribed form obtainable from the office of the Registrar/Scholarship Cell) should reach the Registrar, University of Delhi, Delhi-110007 through the Head of the Institution/Department concerned by the date mentioned in the notification issued by the Registrar in this behalf.
- v) The payment of the scholarship amount shall be made to the scholar through the Head of the Institution/Department from May each year on presentation of a bill and a certificate to the effect that during the period covered in the bill, the scholar was not in receipt of any other scholarship/financial assistance from any other source.
- vi) The unutilized amount in any year shall be added to the corpus of the endowment fund.

** The value of the book grant be at the present accrued annual income on such endowment fund {SC(scholarship) meeting dated 27/1/04 }.
