## Preparation of panel for appointment to the post of Assistant Professor/Lecturer [UR, SC, ST and OBC categories] on ad-hoc basis in Colleges

Applications are invited from candidates, eligible for appointment to the post of Assistant Professor/Lecturer as per UGC Regulations, in the subjects of Economics, English and Computer Science to prepare a panel of candidates belonging to UR, SC, ST and OBC categories for various Colleges of the University.

Interested candidates may send their applications on a plain paper mentioning name, contact address and telephone No., educational qualification and experience etc. to the Deputy Registrar (Colleges), University of Delhi, Delhi 110 007 by post/fax/email (Fax-011-27666431, email: [dr\\_colleges@admin.du.ac.in](mailto:dr_colleges@admin.du.ac.in)). No enclosure is to be attached.

List of candidates would be made available to the Colleges for making appointment to the post of Assistant Professor/Lecturer on ad-hoc basis by following the prescribed procedure. Total emoluments including allowances at the minimum of the Pay Band Rs.15600-39100 + Academic Grade Pay Rs.6000 is Rs. 40,000/- (approx.).

### **Essential Qualification for the post of Assistant Professor/Lecturer (Except Music):**

1. Good academic record with at least 55% (50% for candidates belonging to SC/ST or those who passed their Master's degree prior to 19.09.1991 and hold a Ph.D degree) or an equivalent grade of B in the 7 point scale with letter grades O, A, B, C, D, E & F at the Master's degree level in the relevant subject from an Indian University or an equivalent degree from a foreign University.
2. Candidates should have qualified the National Eligibility Test (NET) for Assistant Professors/ Lecturers conducted by the UGC/CSIR or a similar test accredited by the UGC.

**Note** :- A relaxation in the minimum marks at the post-graduate level from 55% to 50% may be provided to the candidates who have cleared the JRF examination conducted by the UGC/CSIR only, prior to 1989, when the minimum marks required to appear for JRF examination were 50%.

**General Note:-**

1. NET/SLET shall remain the minimum eligibility condition for recruitment and appointment of Lecturer/Assistant Professor; provided however, that candidates who are or have been awarded Ph.D. degree in compliance of the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and procedure for awards of M.Phil./Ph.D. degree), Regulations, 2009 shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET/SLET.
2. Any relaxation in the prescribed qualification can only be made by the UGC in a particular subject in which NET is not being conducted or enough number of candidates are not available with NET qualification.
3. A relaxation of 5% marks (from 55% to 50%) at Master's level to the Persons with Disability (PwD) shall be granted for the post of Lecturer/Assistant Professor in terms of Executive Council Resolution No. 37(2) dated 1.5.2003.
4. The qualifications and other service conditions shall be such as prescribed by the University of Delhi/UGC from time to time.
5. The candidates applying under PwD category may specifically mention in their application main category to which they belong i.e. UR/SC/ST/OBC for the purpose of computing the reservation.
6. The candidates applying under PwD category are required to submit the Disability Certificate in the format prescribed by Government of India, Department of Personnel and Training vide OM No. 36035/3/2004-Estt(Res) dated 29.12.2005. 7. A College may not to fill up any or all the post(s) advertised/available.
