The Annual Convocation of the University of Delhi for presenting the Medals/Prizes to the meritorious students and for conferring upon the Degrees to the successful candidates of the examination 2020 will be held on Saturday, 27th February, 2021 at 10.00 A.M. in the Multipurpose Hall, Delhi University Sports Stadium Complex, University of Delhi, Delhi-110007.

2. **DEGREE "IN PERSON"**

i) Candidate eligible for the award of the following degrees only will be admitted in person at the Convocation.

ii) Each candidate for admission to the Degree in Person and medals/awards should carry an e-invitation card (will be sent is due course of time), a letter duly attested by the Dean of the Faculty/Head of the Department/Supervisor/Principal/Administrative Officer (copy attached) as the case may be and a valid Identity Proof to be produced at the entry of the venue for the Convocation.

4. **DEGREE "IN ABSENTIA"**

5. <u>REHERSAL</u>

There will be a rehearsal on Friday, 26th February, 2021 at 10.00 A.M. in the Multipurpose Hall, Delhi University Sports Stadium Complex, University of Delhi, Delhi-110007 to familiarize the participants.

The recipients of the Degree in person and recipients of Medals and Prizes must attend the rehearsal. They must follow the instructions and remain in their seats in the Multipurpose Hall, Delhi University Sports Stadium Complex till the rehearsal is announced to be over.

6. <u>SEATING ARRANGEMENT IN THE MULTIPURPOSE HALL, DELHI UNIVERSITY SPORTS</u> <u>STADIUM COMPLEX</u>

Candidates who are to receive the Degree in person and all recipients of Medals, Prizes will be allotted a seat. A list showing the allotted seat numbers will be displayed outside the Multipurpose Hall, Delhi University Sports Stadium Complex. Candidate should report latest by 09.00 A.M.
