Tender invitation

We are organizing a Department of Science and Technology sponsored field training workshop for young Earth Scientists on the "Sedimentation, Stratigraphy, and Tectonics along the Jammy-Leh-Shyok transect" from 20th June to 7th July 2014. Following are the details of the programme:

Number of participants: 23 ± 1 (15 participants + 5 mentors + 2 support staff + 1 coordinator; all the mentors will not be available at a time and join from time to time, besides one or two scientists from DST may join in between; information about their joining will be provided in advance).

Tenders are invited from interested companies for the following:

- 1. Transport expenses for the entire trip (On July 7th vehicles would be required to drop the guests from the hotel to the Leh airport). Small vehicles like (Innova/Xylo/XUV 500/Duster etc.) are required.
- 2. Staying arrangement from 20th June to 7th July. In hotel, 2 participants and support staff would share one room while mentors will stay in single room. The tariff of room should be mentioned in the tender.
- 3. Place where hotels are not available stay arrangements should be made in Tents. Tents should be of good quality and sufficient in number. The beddings (i.e., mattress, sleeping bags, quilts etc.) should also be provided in such areas.
- 4. Dinner at Jammu on 20th June and from 21st June 6th July Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner will have to be provided. Breakfast and Lunch should also be provided on 7th July. Menu should include both vegetarian and non-vegetarian items. Non-Vegetarian/Special Vegetarian food should be provided every alternate days.
- 5. Tea/Coffee should be provided 3 times a day and 2 bottles of mineral water also needs to be provided to everyone daily.

Essential requirements: Since this is a geological field training workshop, it is required that the companies having at least 5 years of experience in organizing geological expeditions should only apply. Expertise in the field of Geology with the company will be preferred.
