The University of Delhi announces the Schedule of the Special Cut-off and the 6th and 7th Cut-off of Under-graduate (UG) Courses i.e. B.A. (Prog.) and B.Com in NCWEB is as follows:

Applicants apply for the Special Cut-off	9:00 a.m. - 4 th Dec. 2020(Friday) – 5:00 p.m. 5 th Dec, 2020 (Saturday)
College to approve applicants selected under Special Cut-off	By 5:00 p.m. 7 th Dec, 2020 (Monday)
Last day of payment against Special Cut-off	11:59 p.m. 9 th Dec 2020 (Wednesday)
Admission against 6 th Cut-off	10:00 a.m.12 th Dec, 2020(Saturday) - 5:00 p.m.-14 th Dec 2020 (Monday)
Last day of payment against 6 th Cut-off	11:59 p.m. 16 th Dec 2020 (Wednesday)
Admission against 7 th Cut-off (if required)	10:00 a.m. 19 th Dec (Saturday)-5:00 p.m. 21 st Dec 2020 (Monday)
Last day of payment against 7 th Cut-off	11:59 p.m.23 rd Dec 2020 (Wednesday)

2. The process and policy of taking admission under 6th & 7th Cut-off will be as adopted in the earlier five cut offs.

3. The guidelines for students applying for Special Cut-off is as follows:

- I. Following applicants will be eligible/not eligible to participate in the Special Cut-off
 - (a) Only those applicants will be considered who could not/did not take admission in the initial five Cut-offs for whatsoever reasons.
 - (b) An applicant who has cancelled his/her admission in the 5th Cut-off will not be eligible to participate in the Special Cut-off.
 - (c) Applicants who are already admitted (including NCWEB) in any courses/college of University of Delhi will not be eligible to participate in the Special Cut-off.
- II. **Applicants will apply to a single college+course.** Applicants must ensure that they have carefully checked the number of seats vacant in the course college they are applying to under their category.

- III. The Cut-off for various courses available under each category for a college who would be admitting students under Special Cut-off will be available on the website of NCWEB and University of Delhi on 4th Dec 2020(Friday).
- IV. In case the number of applicants applying for a particular courses in a college is more than the number of seats available, college will make a merit as per the Best of Four/ Best of three required for the course. The college will approve only those numbers of applicants as per the merit, as the number of seats available.
- V. In case of a tie for a seat the following tie-breaking rule shall be applied
- (a) The applicant with higher percentage of marks(aggregate of best five subjects including one language) in the qualifying examination will be considered first for admission.
- (b) The applicant with the earlier date of birth(as mentioned in class X certificate) will be considered for admission.
- VI. Merely applying under the Special Cut-off does not guarantee an admission to the applicant.
- VII. No grievances will be entertained in case an applicant fails to apply or pay the fees (if approved) within the stipulated time period given in the schedule.**
