Dr. Vipin Gupta, Assistant Professor, Department of Anthropology, University of Delhi, has been awarded the prestigious research grant in biomedical sciences and public health i.e. **“Wellcome-Trust-DBT Intermediate Fellowship” (for 5 years) amounting to over Rupees three crores.** Dr. Gupta’s research will be on exploring the role of metabolomics during pregnancy and its influence on fetal growth and development. **Wellcome-Trust/DBT India Alliance** is a collaborative initiative between Wellcome Trust, UK and Department of Biotechnology, India.
