Subject: Exemption from qualifying the typing test on computer after attaining the age of 45 years for the purpose of promotion to the post of Junior Assistant under 25% quota reserved for Multi Tasking Staff (erstwhile Group-D employees) – determining the genuine attempts - regarding.

In pursuance with the Government of India, Ministry of Personnel P.G. & Pensions, (Department of Personnel and Training) O.M. No. 14020/2/91 Estt (D) dated 29th September, 1992 and E.C. resolution no. 52(4) dated 03.05.2002, the criteria for the Genuine Attempt for exemption from qualifying the typing test on computer for promotion to the post of Junior Assistant under 25% quota reserved for Multi Tasking Staff (erstwhile Group 'D'), who have attained the age of 45 years shall be determined as under:

Genuine Attempt:

“A minimum typing speed of 20 w.p.m. on computer in any attempt out of two, may be considered as ‘Genuine Attempt’.”
