No.DE-87(1)-2015 – In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 20 of the Dentists Act, 1948, the Dental Council of India, with the previous sanction of the Central Government, hereby makes the following Amendment to the existing principle Revised BDS Course Regulations, 2007, published in Part III, section 4 of the Gazette of India, Extraordinary, dated 10th September 2007:-

- Short title and commencement:--
 - (i) These Regulations may be called the Revised BDS Course (7th Amendment) Regulations, 2015
 - (ii) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- In Revised BDS Course Regulations, 2007, the following insertion/modifications/deletions/substitutions, shall be as indicated therein:-
- In the existing Regulations under heading captioned as "EXAMINATIONS", sub-heading "SCHEME Examinations" and sub-heading "I B.D.S. Examination:" the existing clause that "Any student who does not clear the I" year BDS examination in all the subjects within 3 years from the date of admission shall be discharged from the course."

Substituted by the following clause that:-

"Any student who does not clear the BDS Course in all the subjects within a period of 9 years, including one year Compulsory Rotatory paid Internship from the date of admission shall be discharged from the course".
