The University of Delhi is participating in the QS Sustainability rankings. There is a requirement for various sustainability goals and policies to be formulated by the University for effective implementation. In alignment with the India's national target of achieving net-zero carbon emissions by 2070, the following sustainability goals are suggested for University of Delhi and included in the policy documents of the University:

1. **Net-Zero Target:** Achieve carbon neutrality across all university operations by **2060**.
2. **Milestones:**
  - 50% emission reduction by **2035**
  - 75% reduction by **2040**
3. **Energy:**
  - 100% renewable energy for all campuses by **2050**
  - Green building standards for all new infrastructure
4. **Waste & Water:**
  - Zero Liquid Discharge by **2040**
  - 90% reduction in non-recyclable waste by **2040**
5. **Transport:**
  - Fully electric university vehicle fleet by **2035**
  - Promote public, cycling, and pedestrian transport
6. **Awareness & Curriculum:**
  - Integrate sustainability into academic programs
  - Conduct regular awareness drives
7. **Monitoring:**
  - Annual sustainability reports
  - Independent audits for progress verification
