

STEPS TO CONNECT TO DU VPN

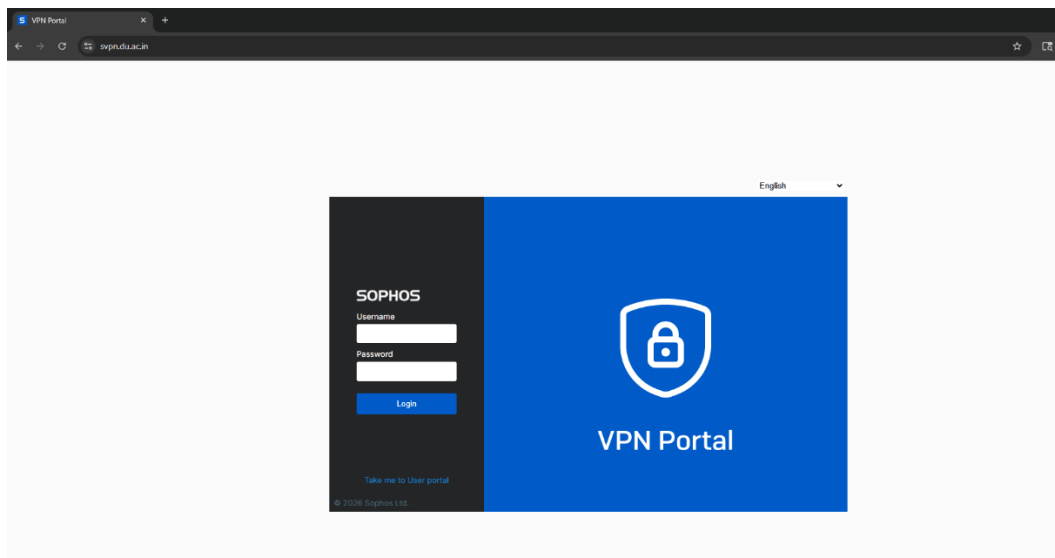
Supported devices

You can use the Sophos Connect client to establish the connection from the following endpoints:

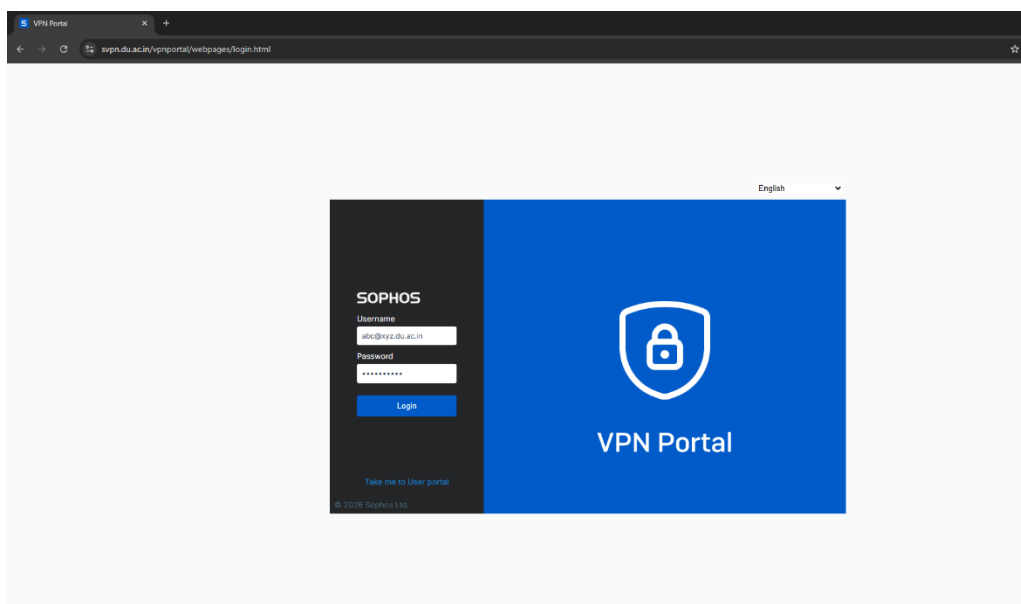
- Windows 10 and 11 devices
- macOS 13.0 and later

Download the Sophos Connect client

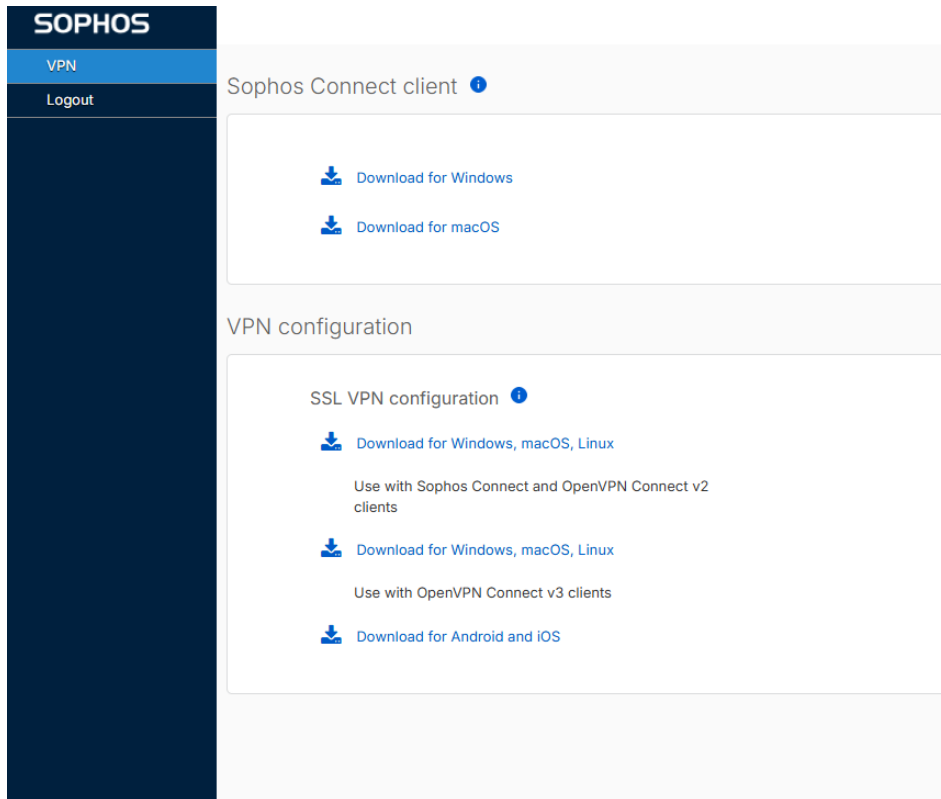
1. Sign in to the VPN portal <https://svpn.du.ac.in>



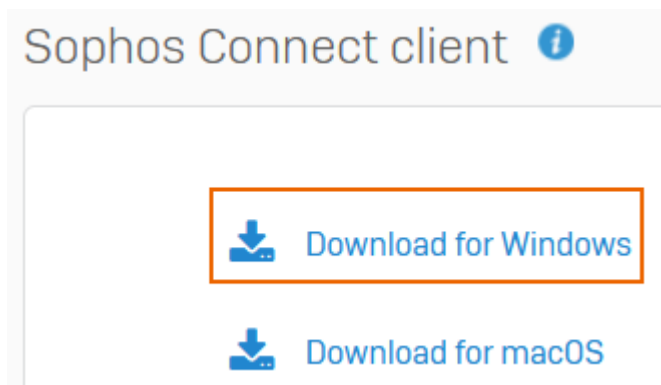
2. Login with your **DU official Email ID & Password**. **(Please note that the login with your personal email id is not permissible for VPN access)**



3. After successful login, the following page will open.



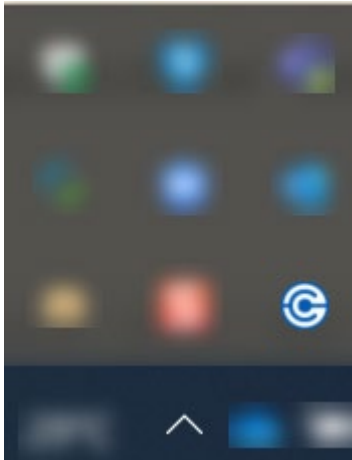
4. Under **Sophos Connect client**, click **Download for Windows** or **Download for macOS**.



5. Click the downloaded file to install the **Sophos Connect** client on your device.

6. Double-click the client.

You can then see it in the tray in the lower-right corner on Windows devices and in the upper-right corner on macOS devices.



7. Download the configuration file

On the VPN portal, under **VPN configuration**, click **Download configuration for Windows, macOS, or Linux** for one of the following options:

You'll download the .ovpn configuration file.

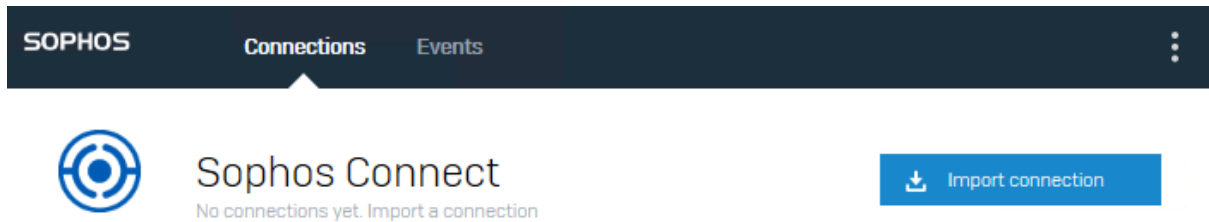

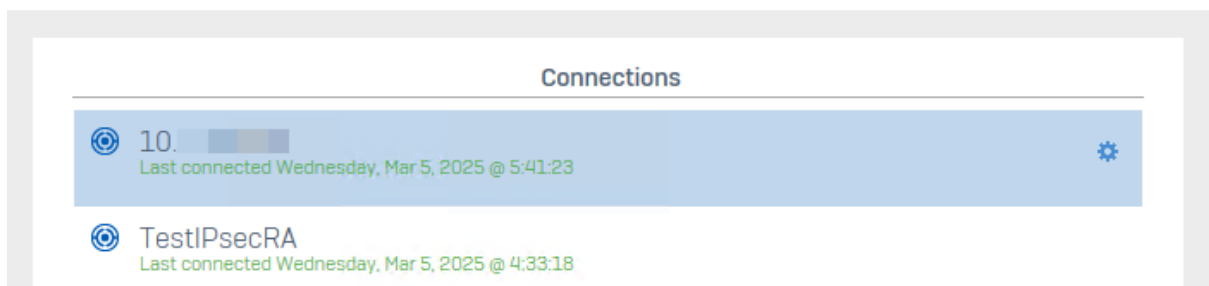
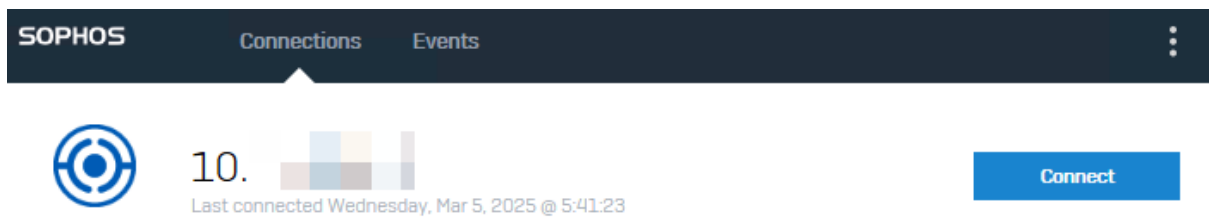
8. Import the configuration file to the client
