The Embassy of Brazil in New Delhi wishes to bring to your kind attention Public Call No. 16/2026 issued by the National Council for Scientific and Technological Development (CNPq), Brazil, under the Graduate-Level Student Agreement Programme (PEC-PG).

1. The programme envisages the award of up to 100 scholarships for Master's programmes and up to 100 scholarships for Doctoral programmes in Brazilian Higher Education Institutions.

2. The selected candidates will be entitled to the following benefits:

(i) Monthly stipend of R\$ 2,100 (Brazilian Real) for Master's programmes (duration up to 24 months) and R\$ 3,100 (Brazilian Real) for Doctoral programmes (duration up to 48 months);

(ii) Access to Brazil's Unified Health System (SUS) on a non-discriminatory basis;

(iii) Return travel allowance, subject to budgetary availability, as per applicable regulations.

3. The selection process under the current call adopts a decentralised framework:

(a) CNPq will first select eligible Brazilian Higher Education Institutions (HEIs) and Institutions of Science and Technology (STIs);

(b) Subsequently, shortlisted institutions will conduct their own admission/selection processes;

(c) Interested candidates will be required to apply directly to the respective institutions, in accordance with programme-specific criteria.

4. As per the notified schedule, the list of selected HEIs/STIs is expected to be published by December 2026. The application processes at the institutional level are expected to take place between March 2027 and March 2028.

5. It is requested that this information may kindly be disseminated among relevant departments, faculty members, and students. Interested candidates are advised to regularly monitor the official portals for updates, detailed eligibility conditions, and programme-specific requirements, including language proficiency criteria.
