 - b) Restructuring fully accommodates the existing workload of teachers in all affected departments teaching these courses. There is no requirement for additional teachers.

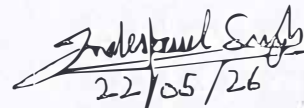

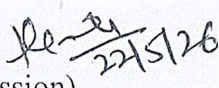
