Background:

The School of Open Learning, University of Delhi provides quality higher education through distance mode under the umbrella of University of Delhi. The name of School of Open Learning was changed from the School of Correspondence Courses & Continuing Education vide EC Res. No.06 dt. 24.11.2003 and was approved vide UGC Letter No. F. No. 8-346/2021(CPP-I/C) dated 22.10.2021.

The University Grant Commission, while superseding the UGC (Open and Distance Learning Regulation 2017) and UGC (Online Courses or Programmes) Regulations-2018 issued UGC (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulation-2020 on 04.09.2020 vide Gazette Notification dt. 18.07.2022 amended the UGC (Open and Distance Learning Programmes and Online Programmes) Regulation 2020.

As per provisions of the amended UGC Regulations 2022, the Higher Education Institution other than Open University intending to offer the programmes under Distance and Online mode shall have a Centre for Distance and Online Education (CDOE).

The relevant extracts of UGC Regulations 2022 Clause 8(3) of Part-III referred above are as under:

“A Higher Educational Institution other than an Open University shall have a designated Centre for Distance and Online Education (CDOE) for operationalising the programmes in Open and Distance Learning mode and/or Online mode, which shall be headed by Director, a regular functionary on fulltime dedicated basis not below the rank of an Associate Professor and shall have appropriate and adequate academic, technical, administrative staff and infrastructural resources.”

- (ii) Such faculty members shall be eligible for NPS from their date of appointment on regular basis.
- (iii) The past service at Pay Level-10 may be considered for promotion as per prevailing UGC Regulations and/or University of Delhi rules.
- (iv) Each cases is to examined by the respective college and seek concurrence of the University prior to implementing the recommendation of protection of pay.
- (v) These recommendations will be applicable for appointment made since 1st April 2022.

The Executive Council considered and approved the transfer of assets, and corpus accumulated user charges, of BioNEST-UDSC (a BIRAC-funded project) to BioNEST-UDSC-Association of Scientific & Technological Research Activities (BioNEST-UDSC-ASTRA), a Section 8 company that was incorporated under the University of Delhi (CIN: U85500DL2026NPL466589) after due approval from the Executive Council, University of Delhi (EC resolution no 27 dated 12.07.2025).

Background:

1. BioNEST-UDSC-Association of Scientific and Technological Research Activities (BioNEST-UDSC-ASTRA) was incorporated on 15th May 2026 (CIN: U85500DL2026NPL466589; **Appendix-22**) with the purpose of fostering an ecosystem that promotes entrepreneurship and creates an environment of self-employment in the area of Life Sciences, particularly in the fields of medical biotechnology and agri-industrial biotechnology. This Section 8 company would serve as a non-profit interface between the institutions of learning and research in the Delhi-NCR area and the biotech start-up sector. Through laboratory infrastructure and high-end equipment, as well as mentorship, it aim to nurture young life science professionals from the University of Delhi and beyond, encouraging them to become innovators and to develop new technologies and products.
2. Through its activities BioNEST-UDSC-ASTRA aims to continue, carry forward, and extend the activities of BioNEST-UDSC, thus far been run as a BIRAC-funded project, which ended on 20-07-2026.
3. The first Board meeting of BioNEST-UDSC-ASTRA was held on 10.06.2026 and it was decided by the Board that the Assets and Corpus accumulated funds of BioNEST-UDSC would be transferred to BioNEST-UDSC-ASTRA subject to the NOC from BIRAC.
