INSTRUCTIONS TO THE STUDENTS

1. The Annual Convocation of the University of Delhi for presenting the Medals/Prizes to the meritorious students and for conferring upon the Degrees to the successful candidates of the examination 2025 will be held on Saturday, 28th February, 2026 at 7.30 a.m. in the Multipurpose Hall, Delhi University Sports Stadium Complex, University of Delhi, Delhi-110007.

2. **DEGREE "IN PERSON"**

- i) Candidate eligible for the award of the following degrees only will be admitted in person at the Convocation.

1. Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) in all disciplines	8. D.M. (Neuro-Anaesthesia)
2. D.M. (Cardiology)	9. M.Ch. (Cardio-Vascular and Thoracic Surgery)

- ii) Each candidate for admission to the Degree in Person and **medals/awards/winner** should carry an e-invitation card (**will be sent in due course of time**), a letter duly attested by the Dean of the Faculty/Head of the Department/Supervisor/Principal/Administrative Officer (copy attached) as the case may be and a valid Identity Proof to be produced at the entry of the venue for the Convocation.

- iii) Ph.D. Candidates are advised to visit **Ph.D. Students Portal:-** (https://durslt.du.ac.in/Du_Online_PhD/R9_Notice_Board/Notice_Board_Students.aspx) for their Result, those students whose result are declared till 5:00 p.m. on 26.02.2026 are eligible for award of degree in the 102nd Annual Convocation.

3. **DEGREE "IN ABSENTIA"**

The degree in case of candidates who fail to receive the same in Person at the Convocation will be sent to their respective Faculty/Department/Centre after the Convocation.

4. **REHEARSAL**

There will be a rehearsal on Friday, the **27th February, 2026 at 02.00 p.m.** in the Multipurpose Hall, Delhi University Sports Stadium Complex, University of Delhi, Delhi-110007 to familiarize the participants. The recipients of the Degree in person and recipients of Medals and Prizes must attend the rehearsal. They must follow the instructions and remain in their seats in the Multipurpose Hall, Delhi University Sports Stadium Complex till the rehearsal is announced to be over.

5. **SEATING ARRANGEMENT IN THE MULTIPURPOSE HALL, DELHI UNIVERSITY SPORTS STADIUM COMPLEX**

Candidates who are to receive the Degree in person and all recipients of Medals, Prizes will be allotted a seat. A list showing the allotted seat numbers will be displayed outside the Multipurpose Hall, Delhi University Sports Stadium Complex. **Candidate should report latest by 7.30 a.m.**

IMPORTANT: Both Parents/Guests and Supervisor of the Ph.D. Awardees will be allowed with the candidate in the **Multipurpose Hall, Delhi University Sports Stadium Complex.**

6. **ACADEMIC COSTUMES**


Candidates must appear in academic costume (Stole/Angvasra) in the Convocation, Candidates are advised to contact the **Souvenir Shop, Delhi University Women's Association (DUWA) 7, Chhatra Marg, University of Delhi, Delhi-110007** Phone No: **011-27666851** to purchase (**not refundable**) the academic Costumes for the Convocation.

7. **SPECIAL INSTRUCTIONS**

The Candidates are advised to adhere to the following instructions to maintain the sanctity and tradition of the Convocation Ceremony:

- i) No request for receiving the degree/medal/prize "in Person" shall be entertained once the final roll call is over.
- ii) As the procession enters the Hall, kindly stand up and keep standing till members of the procession take their respective seats.
- iii) Maintain silence during the entire ceremony.
- iv) Stand up for the Vande Matram/National Anthem/Delhi University Kulgeet and remain standing till the Procession, Distinguished Guest and other guests leave the Hall.
- v) Follow the instructions of the officials on duty in the Hall.
- vi) Items such as electronic gadget, hand bags and any kind of **arms/sharp objects** are not allowed inside the venue. There will be no arrangement for safe keeping of belongings at the venue.
- vii) No food and drinking items will be allowed inside the Venue.
- viii) Use of Delhi Metro Rail for commuting should be preferred as parking facility is very limited.
- ix) **Mobile phones are not allowed inside the venue.**
