PRESS RELEASE

An online meeting of the University Proctor and his team with all Principals of Colleges, Head of the Departments, Hostels authorities, DUSU office bearers and Delhi Police Officials was held on **20 July, 2026 at 11:30 a.m.** to deliberate upon measures for facilitating the smooth induction of students during the opening of the new academic session 2026-27. Many important decisions were taken in the meeting to ensure the maintenance of discipline and the prevention of ragging in the University and College campuses. In this connection, the Colleges/Departments and Hostels have been requested to strictly enforce the rules and regulations issued from time to time, especially the provisions of Ordinances XV-B, XV-C, and the Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and Redressal) Act, 2013 (14 of 2013)

The following specific measures were discussed which need to be taken up during the academic session 2026-27 are:

1. The Hon'ble Supreme Court judgement on ragging has to be strictly followed by all concerned. All students/hostel residents, as well as their parents/guardians, have been asked to give an undertaking to this effect at the time of admission to respective Colleges/Departments/Centres/Halls/Hostels as per the web portal (<http://www.antiragging.in>)
2. The University will set up two Joint Control Rooms, one each in the North and South Campuses (North Campus Tel. No. 011-27667221 and South Campus Tel. No. 011-24119832), beginning from **28th July, 2026 till 07th August, 2026.**
3. The Anti-Ragging Banners in bilingual (English and Hindi) will be installed at the strategic locations in North and South Campuses, University of Delhi, before 28th July, 2026. As well as the Anti-Ragging Posters in bilingual (English and Hindi) have also been provided to all Colleges/Departments/Hostels for display on the Notice Board and other strategic locations.
4. Colleges/Centres/Hostels have been requested to restrict the entry of outsiders, and to prominently display rules regarding the prohibition of ragging in their respective institutions.
5. All Colleges/Faculties/Departments/Hostels have been requested to form Anti-ragging/Disciplinary Committee & Vigilance Squad, taking help of NCC/NSS student volunteers wherever possible to monitor ragging.
6. Placing of police pickets outside every college, with special assistance being provided to women's colleges. Any acts of indiscipline, ragging will be dealt with strictly under the University's Statutes, Ordinances, which give legal authority to Principals/Heads/ Directors/ Provosts/Wardens to take preventive as well as punitive action,

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wherever required. Police assistance will be sought whenever the situation warrants direct intervention by them.

7. Patrolling has also been enforced to monitor and take speedy action in case of any untoward incident in the Campus.
8. Delhi police has assured that women police in plain clothes will be deployed in the University as well as outside the premises of each college. In case of any ragging or eve-teasing, the police will take care of the offenders. Students desirous of paying guest accommodation must ensure that their PG is duly verified by the local Police since all such PGs are regularly monitored by the area Police for proper safety and security of the student residents.
9. Police officials were requested to highlight steps for receiving ragging complaints, as detailed below. Authorities were apprised of the ragging online. They were suggested to report the complaint to the Cyber Crime.
10. The UGC has formulated strict guidelines to curb the menace of ragging, which were given on their website www.ugc.ac.in. As per "UGC regulations on curbing the menace of ragging in higher educational Institutes, 2009", the Principal/Head/Provost shall during the first three months of an academic year, submit weekly report on the status of compliance with Anti-ragging measures under these regulations and monthly report on such status thereafter.
