REVISED PUBLICATION POLICY

for

Strides – A Students' Journal of Shri Ram College of Commerce
[ISSN 2581-4931 (Print)]

The Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE) follows a 3-Stage Selection Process while approving a paper for publication in Strides. The revised publication policy is as follows:

Stage-1. Call for Research Papers

The soft copy of the manuscript should be sent *via* e-mail to the editor at strides@srcc.du.ac.in along with the following:

- (1) Duly Signed Scanned Copy of Declaration by Author(s) (specimen copies are attached);
- (2) Plagiarism Report generated on Turnitin (*10% of similarity); and
- (3) AI (Artificial Intelligence) Report generated on Turnitin (*extent of use of AI upto 20%).

Above mentioned all the three documents needs to be verified mandatorily. After verification, research papers are sent to the *Referees* (Subject Experts) for Double-Blind Peer Review.

Stage-2. Double-Blind Peer Review

The journal adheres to a rigorous double-blind peer review policy. Each research paper received by the editor is sent for review to the *Referee* (Subject Expert). The reports submitted by the *Referees* are sent to the respective author(s) for improvement (if any, suggested by the *Referees*). After addressing all the points / suggestions recommended by the *Referees*, the revised and improved version of the papers needs to be re-submitted by the author(s) along with the above mentioned all the three documents for the revised paper.







If a research paper is rejected by the *Referee*, no further proceedings are taken into account. Once rejected by the expert means cannot be published at all.

Stage-3. Approval by Committee on Publication Ethics (COPE)

After double-blind peer review and screening of plagiarism and AI, the revised research papers are submitted for final approval and selection of best three papers to the COPE (Committee on Publication Ethics). The research papers approved by the COPE are finally sent for publication.

Since COPE is the apex authority to take all decisions related to publication of research papers and articles in 'Strides – A Students' Journal of Shri Ram College of Commerce', the decision of COPE shall be final and binding.
