1. Research Associate (01 Post)

- Coordinate field surveys and research activities.
- Data compilation, analysis and interpretation.
- Preparation of project reports, policy briefs and publications.
- Liaison with project stakeholders and government agencies.

2. Research Assistant (02 Posts)
