

Interactive Session on Reimagining Equality: Inclusive Legal Frameworks in Education

Strengthening Social Responsibility and Institutional Sensitivity

The Department of Environmental Studies, University of Delhi, organized a lecture on **“Reimagining Equality: Addressing Discrimination in Educational Institutions Through Inclusive Legal Frameworks”** on 19 February 2026.

The session, delivered by a legal expert from the Supreme Court of India, provided participants with a critical understanding of legal protections, institutional responsibilities, and mechanisms to address discrimination within educational spaces.

The lecture facilitated meaningful engagement with:

- legal dimensions of equality and non-discrimination
- institutional roles in ensuring inclusive environments
- rights-based approaches in higher education
- ethical and social dimensions of sustainability

By foregrounding issues of equity and justice, the initiative reinforced the Department’s broader commitment to inclusive and socially responsible academic environments.

This effort contributed to building awareness and sensitivity among students, faculty, and staff, strengthening the role of educational institutions in fostering fair, inclusive, and accountable systems.
