1	The total credit required for Ph.D. coursework ranges from 12 to 16 credits. The distribution of minimum 12 credits is as follows:	
	a. Research Methodology Or Advanced Research methodology (for students who have already studied Research Methodology)	4 Credit
	b. Research Publication Ethics	2 Credits
	c. Research Tools	2 Credits
	d. Discipline Specific Elective Course (Relevant to the research areas)	4 Credits

	Additional 4 credits may be obtained from a DSE, if required. This will be applicable in specialised area and such course(s) should not have been offered at PG studies
2	Teaching hours of the Ph.D. coursework are included in the workload of faculty.
3	The courses offered in the Ph.D coursework should be of higher level than those offered in the post-graduate programmes.
