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Appendix -13 in the Winutes

- (a) The Minutes of the last meeting of the Faculty of Medical Sciences held by 17.11.2014 was confirmed
- (b) Arising out of the minutes: Item No. 2: Prof. Gopesh Mehrotra and Prof. Iqbal Singh dissented and Item No. 6 of the minutes of the faculty meeting dated 17.11.2014:— Hindu Rao Hospital is affiliated with 1P University for imparting MBBS course. This hospital is also running Diploma in Anesthesiology (DA) course (Two seats) under the Faculty of Medical Sciences, University of Delhi. Since, this hospital has dual academic control for imparting UG & PG courses, it would be appropriate that the two Diploma seats of Anesthesiology be also taken over by 1.P. University.

The Faculty members suggested that Hindu Rao Hospital be asked to discontinue the affiliation of two seats Diploma in Anesthesiology (DA) Course from Delhi University.

Item No. 7 & 8: The merger of Faculty of Homeopathic Medicine & Faculty of Ayurveda & Unani Medicine, Establishment of a Separate Faculty of Paramedical Sciences/Deptt. Does not comes under the purview of the Faculty. Item No. 9 of the minutes of the faculty meeting dated 17.11 2014. Prof. Gopesh Mehrotra said that in place where his name was written as dissenting 15.7 – (number of examination) was incorrect.

The Dean (Medical) informed the faculty members that there have been many changes in MCI regulation for UG/ Postgraduate. Super Specialty Therefore, there is need to revise the University Ordinance in the light of the amendments. An Ordinance Committee will review the amendments in the Ordinance and recommendations of Ordinance Committee may be placed before faculty meeting. Hence, discussion on Item 9 of the minutes of faculty meeting held on 17.11.2014 may be deferred till the Committee submits their suggestions/recommendations. The faculty members approved the same.

The Faculty considered the change of nomenclature of M.Ch Plastic Surgery to M.Ch (Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery) as per the Medical Council of India Regulations:

### Note:

- 1. Inspection for starting M.Ch (Plastic Surgery) course was held 20.08.2014 at MAMC and report of inspection committee was approved by Vice Chancellor on 02.09.2014.
- 2. Pursuant to this Faculty of Medical Sciences issued "Consent of Affiliation" Certificate towards starting of M.Ch (Plastic Surgery) course at MAMC with intake of 06 seats.
- 3. The Consultant & Head, Burn & Plastic Surgery Department, LNJP Hospital vide letter no. F.No.99/M.Ch/B&P/HOD/LNH/2013/2071 dated 17.01.2015 requested for fresh consent of affiliation, since MAMC needed to apply a fresh permission from Medical Council of India (MCI) for the session 2016 onwards.
- 4. Accordingly, Faculty of Medical Sciences issued afresh "Consent of Affiliation" certificate, vide letter no. FMDS/247 272/New/Increase Seats/MAMC/2015/7327 dated 23.01.2015.
- 5. The Dean, Maulana Azad Medical College informed that the nomenclature of the course is M.Ch (Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery) and for requested Change of nomenclature of M.Ch Plastic Surgery to M.Ch (Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery) vide letter no F403(22)/2014/MCC(Aca)/6795 dated 05.04.2017.

The Faculty after a length of discussion approved the change of nomenclature of M.Ch Plastic Surgery to M.Ch (Plastic & Reconstructive Surgery) as per the Medical Council of India Regulations
