


<p>Ordinance IX Clause 12 :</p> <p>Pass Percentage and Promotion Rules for All the Under-Graduate Courses under Choice Based Credit System</p> <p>Sub Clause 12 (1)(b) :</p> <p>A student who has obtained 40% on the aggregate taking together all the papers in theory examination (including internal assessment /project work) and practical examination separately conducted in 1st and 11nd semester shall be promoted to the second academic year/111rd semester</p> <p>Sub Clause 12 (1)(c) :</p> <p>A student who has obtained 40% on the aggregate taking together all the papers in theory examination (including internal assessment /project work) and practical examination separately conducted in 1st and 11nd semester shall be promoted to the second academic year/111rd semester</p> <p>Sub Clause 12 (1) (d) :</p> <p>Students who do not fulfill the promotion criteria mentioned above shall be declared fail in the promotion examination of the academic year concerned.</p> <p>Sub Clause 12 (1)(e) :</p> <p>If a student has secured an aggregate of minimum 40% marks taking together all the papers in theory examination (including internal assessment /project, wherever applicable) and practical exam separately till the end of the third year, i.e., upto the end of the VIth semester, then she/he shall be awarded the degree in which the student has been admitted.</p>	<p>Passing and Promotion Rules for all the Under-Graduate Courses under Choice Based Credit System</p> <p>Passing Rules:</p> <p>The results shall be prepared on the basis of the formula prescribed as at <i>Table 'A'</i> with minor changes in the computation of grade cut off as at <i>Table 'B'</i>. The passing criteria of attaining 40% marks in numerical value is therefore to be 'deleted'.</p> <p>Promotion Rules:</p> <p>A student shall be eligible for promotion from 1st year to 2nd year/111 semester provided he/she has passed 50% papers of I and II semester taken together and similarly for promotion from 2nd year to 3rd year/V semester</p> <p>The students shall be declared fail as per the formula prescribed by UGC at <i>Table 'A'</i>. However, they shall have the option to retain the marks in the paper in which they want to retain.</p> <p>Eligibility for award of degree :</p> <p>A student shall be declared eligible for degree provided he/she has passed all the papers of 1st year, 2nd year and 3rd year of a course as per approval of the Executive Council (EC Resolution No. CNC-II/093/2015-16 dated 28th September, 2015)</p>
