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MINUTES

The Second meeting of the Task Force Committee constituted by the Competent Authority was held on 13.02.2017 at 03.00 p.m. at Registrar's Committee room.

The Joint Registrar (Finance) assisted the Task Force committee in the proceedings.

After detailed deliberations, the committee recommended the following:

- (i) Since MHRD vide letter No. F.4-41/2014 –Desk (U) dated 23rd January 2017 in connection with the CPF-GPF issue has directed to allow GPF/Pension of Government in respect of those employees who were in the service on 1.1.86 unless they have specifically and in writing chosen the option to stay with CPF, the pension case files in respect of employees covered under the Category I (N.K. Bakshi batch) and Category III (Virmani batch), may be processed on priority basis.
- (ii) The directives given vide MHRD letter dated 23/01/2017 may be implemented in toto.
- (iii) An appeal may be filed against the order of the Division bench of the Hon'ble High court of Deihi dated 24.8.2016 in respect of Category II (Shashi Kiran batch) in the Apex Court in consultation with the UGC and the MHRD. The committee was of the view that the opinion of the

senior counsel who argued the matter before the Division Bench may also be obtained before filing the appeal.

- (iv) The case files have to be processed on a case to case basis individually. The onus of burden of proof that the employees had not submitted their option form (to continue under the CPF scheme) within the stipulated period lies with the individual institution/college/department.
- (v) It was brought to the notice of the committee that implementation of the judgment in a time bound manner will involve substantial work which is difficult to be carried out by the existing regular staff. In view of the quantum of work and the expertise involved, 3 or 4 experienced individuals may be engaged /employed on contract basis for expeditious disposal of these cases.

The meeting ended with vote of thanks to the Chair.
