On perusal of the report of the Inspection Committee referred above, it has been noted that the above Inspection Committee has inter-alia recommended that the request of the College may be considered subject to the following stipulations:

- Florence Nightingale College of Nursing must appoint the required faculty to teach the course as per the guidelines approved by the Nursing Council of India and shall apply for grant-in-aid to the Ministry of Health and Family Welfare, Govt. of India/UGC/Govt. of NCT of Delhi, as the case may be, to run the course.

- Florence Nightingale College of Nursing will follow the rules and regulations framed by the University and would take up the matter for providing grant-in-aid with the funding agency expeditiously.
