Requisites:

1. Essential Qualifications :

- (i) A Master's degree with 55% marks (or an equivalent grade in a point-scale wherever the grading system is followed) in a concerned/relevant/allied subject from an Indian University, or an equivalent degree from an accredited foreign University.
- (ii) Besides fulfilling the above qualifications, the candidate must have cleared the National Eligibility Test (NET) conducted by the UGC or the CSIR (exemption from NET shall be granted in accordance with the clause

The National Eligibility Test (NET) shall be the minimum eligibility for appointment of Assistant Professor.

Provided that candidates who have been awarded a Ph.D. Degree in accordance with the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil./Ph.D Degree) Regulation, 2009, or the University Grants Commission (Minimum Standards and Procedure for Award of M.Phil/Ph.D Degree) Regulation, 2016, and their subsequent amendments from time to time, as the case may be, shall be exempted from the requirement of the minimum eligibility condition of NET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professor in the University.

Provided further that the award of degree to candidates registered for the M.Phil/Ph.D. programme prior to July 11,2009, shall be governed by the provisions of the then existing Ordinances/Bye-laws/Regulations of the Institutions awarding the degree. All such Ph.D. candidates shall be exempted from the requirement of NET for recruitment and appointment of Assistant Professors in the Colleges subject to the fulfilment of the following conditions :

- (a) The Ph.D. degree of the candidate has been awarded in regular mode only;
- (b) The Ph.D. thesis has been awarded by at least two external examiners;
- (c) An open Ph.D. viva voce of the candidate has been conducted;
- (d) The candidate has published two research papers from her/his Ph.D. work out of which at least one is in a refereed journal;
- (e) The candidate has presented at least two papers, based on her/his Ph.D. work in conference/seminars sponsored/funded/supported by the UGC/ICSSR/CSIR or any similar agency. The fulfilment of these conditions is to be certified by the Registrar or the Dean (Academic Affairs) of the University concerned.

2. Work Experience (Desirable) :

At least three years post qualification experience in content writing and development (preferably in the Self Learning Material format) for Open and Distance Learning Programmes for the above mentioned UG and PG programmes. Candidates with prior experience of preparing e-content and MOOCs for the UG and PG Programmes will be preferred.

Remuneration:

The remuneration for content writing will be paid as per the approved rates of the School of Open Learning, University of Delhi, Delhi – 110007.

The Interested candidates with the required qualifications and experience, and possessing good writing and presentation skills, may submit their applications online in the prescribed format available on the SOL website <https://sol.du.ac.in> . The last date of submission of online application is 5th January, 2024.
