Name of the Programme: Master of Business Administration (MBA)

A. PROGRAMME OBJECTIVES AND OUTCOMES.

MBA Programme is designed to create dynamic, efficient, skilled and strategic professionals who are ready to take and handle various corporate challenges, under the disciplined guidelines of Ethics and Governance. Programme provides the pathways to create values with keeping the social welfare in core and tries to assure that the qualified professionals should be future business leaders contributing in National Economy. The programme nurtures and develops world-class business leaders with personalized core and attention.
