Subject: Framing of syllabi of NCC General Elective Credit Course – reg.

1. The inclusion of NCC as a General Elective Credit Course in the University has been approved by the Academic Council and Executive Council vides AC and EC Resolution Nos. 12(12-1) dated 24.08.2021 and 8[8-1(8-1-1)] dated 30.08.2021 respectively. (Annexure – 1)
2. The proposed course design for NCC General Elective Credit Course provided by the Directorate General of NCC (DG NCC) has been examined. As per the course design, NCC is offered as
 - General Elective Course in six semesters,
 - with non-uniform course credits across the semesters and
 - proposed syllabi of these six semesters are interlinked. (Annexure-2)
3. In Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) operating in the University,
 - Firstly, the General Elective courses are offered in four semesters in case of Honours courses (Semester I, II, III & IV) and in two semesters in the case of B.A./B.Com. Programmes (Semester V & VI). Therefore, the proposed design provided by DG NCC requires to be reorganized to fit into the existing scheme of the University.
 - Secondly, the General Electives offered in the University uniformly carry six credits each unlike that of the proposed course design of DG NCC.
 - Thirdly, the syllabus of the NCC General Elective course per semester has to be made self-contained and independent of the syllabi of the NCC GE papers offered in the other semesters so that the freedom to choose any other GE course is kept open for students under CBCS.
4. In view of the points mentioned at 3 above, it is proposed that a Committee may be constituted in order to formulate the syllabi of the NCC GE courses keeping in view the framework approved by the AC and EC.

The proposed Committee may consist of the following:

- i. Captain Parminder Sehgal, Officer-in-Charge, NCC, DU
- ii. Captain Sanjay Kumar Sharma, Associate NCC Officer, Ram Lal Anand College
- iii. Captain Keshav Saini, Associate NCC Officer, Dyal Singh College
- iv. Col. Sushil Bugalia, CO 5DBN – External Expert from DG.NCC
