To Consider the proposal for submission to HEFA for funding for Infrastructure Development and Creation of Capital Assets

NOTE:

As per the present financing pattern of HEFA the University is covered under Window III category of financing (Central Universities established before 2014) where the University has to Repay 10% of the Principal Loan Amount in 20 half yearly installments. The Interest component will be served by the Govt. of India.

The Ministry of Education has communicated that Major infrastructure projects will be funded through HEFA only and the proposal needs to be submitted to the Ministry of Education. No funds on this count will be released as Budgetary support (i.e. Grant under OH:35).

The University is receiving a very limited allocation for creation of Capital Assets since last 3-5 years and due to which the university is not able to develop any infrastructure or incur expenditure on creation of capital Assets within this very limited allocation. With this very small amount, the university is not able to purchase even single major lab equipment for the departmental academic and other research activities.

The buildings of the University are very old and in a dilapidated conditions as well as sufficient spaces are not available for academic activities where a generous growth in enrollment of students has taken places as well as increasing year by year. As such several buildings as well as renovation of the existing buildings are urgently required for academic activities and accommodation the large number of students of different faculties.

The Equipments of laboratories were purchased several years ago has become obsolete, as new technological developments have taken place. Due to non availability of Proper and latest technology based laboratory equipment, the Academic as well as research activities are badly affected in the university and needs to be replaced on urgent basis, which will not only help University in getting higher ranking but also in getting national & international awards.

The University is planning to submit proposal to **HEFA for funding of Rs.1075.40 Crores** for Infrastructure Development and Creation of Capital Assets.

As per HEFA funding pattern, the University has to repay Rs. 107.54 Crores in 20 (Twenty) half yearly Installments over a period of 10 years i.e. a sum of approx. Rs.5.07 crores every Six months.

The matter is placed for consideration by the Committee.
