This is to inform you that **Holi Festival** will be celebrated on **25<sup>th</sup> March, 2024**. The University is to gear itself to curb any menace of hooliganism in the name of Holi festival and to avoid any untoward incident during the Festival on the University Campus and in its Colleges.

The University, has taken necessary steps to make elaborate internal and external security arrangements on the Campus, its affiliated colleges and hostels, to combat acts of hooliganism and rowdyism in the name of Holi festival causing harm to members of the University community, particularly the girl students. Anyone who is found to be indulging in such acts of indiscipline and causing harassment would be subjected to strict disciplinary action under the provision of University Ordinances, and the Sexual Harassment of Women at Work Place Act-2013.

The University seeks your cooperation and support in order to maintain the spirit of Holi in a dignified manner by monitoring discipline on the Campus and in the Colleges. Kindly activate your Proctorial Boards/Disciplinary Committees for maintaining discipline during the festival and also to inspire feeling of confidence among students especially girls.

We are also seeking necessary cooperation and support from the Law and Order authorities, Metro and the DTC officials to maintain peace and harmony and monitoring the situation so as to avoid untoward incidents during the Holi Festival.

The JOINT CONTROL ROOM on the North and South campuses will be in operation along with Delhi Police. The DU internal security staff will closely monitor incidents for taking timely action to maintain peace and order.

The Holi Guideline and Poster are enclosed for display on the notice board of your institution.

I solicit your kind cooperation on this matter and request for timely action to curb hooliganism and to maintain discipline and harmony during Holi Festival.
