Project: “Understanding the Law, Life world and Marginality of Religious Converts in Southern States of India (F. No. ICSSR/RPD/MJ/2023-24/ST/44)

Designation: Research Assistants (2 positions for maximum 10 months) and Field Investigators (4 positions for maximum 6 months), and Consultants and Research Interns (on honorary basis) for the ICSSR sponsored Research Programme. The number and duration of research staff's appointments may change as per the requirements determined by the Principal Investigator and Co-Principal Investigator.

Application Requirements:

Research Assistant: PhD/MPhil/Post-graduate in a social science discipline with a minimum of 55% marks. Prior experience in field research, editing, and report writing is preferable.

Consultant & Field Investigator: Post-graduate in any social science discipline with a minimum of 55% marks with prior experience in research, writing, data analysis, data collection, etc.

Research Intern: Graduate in any social science and humanities with prior experience in research, writing, data analysis, data collection, etc.

Work Description:

- The research staff are required to contribute to the management and research tasks of this project, assisting in administrative work, field visits, data collection, analysis and report writing. Candidates should be highly motivated to learn on the job, committed to the project work, and have a flair for teamwork. Research staffs are required to travel outside Delhi to undertake field research.
- The continuation of selected candidates for project work is subject to the satisfaction of the Principal Investigator and Co-Principal Investigator. The period and number of research staff is variable as per the requirement determined by PI and Co-PI during the project work. Honorarium of selected candidates shall be governed by the rules/guidelines stipulated by both the University of Delhi and ICSSR and fixed by the Principal Investigator/selection committee. Appearance in the interview doesn't guarantee the candidate's selection for the said research work. No TA and DA will be paid for appearing in the interview.
