Background:

1. There were concerns expressed regarding the implementation of 4th Year UG programmes for students of the School of Open Learning and NCWEB. The operationalization of the three tracks of the 4th Year UG programmes, viz. Dissertation writing, Academic Projects and Entrepreneurship may be challenging in view of the quantum of students who may possibly progress to the 4th year. There was thus a need to bring in some flexibility to students for the 4th Year.
2. In this regard, it was noted that students pursuing B.A. (P) or B.Sc. (P) or B.Com. (P) will get a simple degree after completion of 3rd year and an Honours degree after completion of 4th year. Such students will not get ‘Honours with Research’ degree after completion of the 4th year even if such students write ‘Dissertation’ or do ‘Academic Projects’.
3. Accordingly, it is proposed that an alternative may be provided to students enrolled in B.A. (P) or B.Sc. (P) or B.Com. (P) who will be pursuing the 4th year of their UG programmes to opt for additional number of Discipline Specific Electives and a Skill based course of two credits related to the core discipline each in the Semesters VII and VIII, in case they do not wish to opt for any of the three approved tracks aforementioned. The alternate structure proposed is provided below:

Alternate 4th Year B.A. (P), B.Sc. (P) and B.Com.(P) structure for those who do not wish to opt for Dissertation writing/Academic Projects/ Entrepreneurship

4. However, this structure shall not be applicable for those students who are enrolled in Single Core Discipline Programmes (conventionally known as 'Honours' Programme i.e. programmes where students get Honours degree in three years).

7-34/ The Council resolved that the proposal for enabling implementation of cumulative improvement of marks of a course/ paper, be accepted.

Background:

1. The improvement of marks in a course/paper was approved by the AC and EC and notified vide Notification no. CNC-II/093/1(22)/2022-23/ dated 10.02.2023.
2. Due to overlapping of classes of different semesters, students who wish to improve their marks cumulatively of a course(s), including the IA and CA/Practical components, of a course/paper of earlier semester, find it challenging. A committee, chaired by the Director South Delhi Campus, was constituted by the competent authority to examine the matter. Further, a meeting held on 16.04.2025, chaired by the Hon'ble Vice Chancellor, wherein Principals of the Colleges and Head of Departments where UG courses are being offered, also discussed the matter.
3. As per the discussion in the meeting, which also emerged out of the deliberations of the Committee, the following are proposed:
 - a. (i) A student who has passed in a course/paper in an earlier semester, but wishes to improve the marks of both the theory (written exam marks) and Internal Assessment (IA) but excluding the attendance component of the IA, may be allowed to carry forward their previous attendance marks of IA and improve upon the rest of the two components i.e. Class Test and Assignment by re-registering for the course/paper and learning through self-study mode.
 - (ii) To 'Re-register' for a course/paper means to formally inform the College authority by a student of his/her intent to improve a course/paper. College may create a proforma /Google Form to seek such information from the students and may charge a very nominal fee (maximum Rs. 100/-) to systematize the process.

- b. To overcome the issue of overlapping of the classes of the current semester and that of the class timings of the course of an earlier semester which a student wishes to improve the marks cumulatively, the following are proposed as per the deliberations:
- (i) Holding of classes of such students from 6 to 8 pm OR on Saturdays or Sundays or both the days
 - (ii) In case of less number of students who wish to improve the marks of a course/paper in a College, Colleges can cluster together and hold classes of such course(s)/paper(s).
 - (iii) Faculty members of the College who take classes for these students at the timing or days mentioned in point 4. (b) (i) may be paid honorarium as per norms of the University if they take such classes over and above their prescribed workload in the College. However, a faculty member may be permitted to teach a maximum of four credits in a semester for such students.
- c. For the sake of avoiding any confusion whatsoever, it is reiterated that as per Ordinance IX (2), improvement of marks obtained in a course/paper can be made in the immediately succeeding odd/even semester only. However, if a student has got an 'Essential Repeat' in a course/paper in the relevant semester, he/she may be allowed to appear for that paper and improve the components of that paper till the time he/she passes that course/paper. For instance, if a student fails in a course of semester I, he/she has to repeat in semester III, but if he/she again fails in that course/paper in semester III, then he/she shall be allowed to appear again in semester V.

7-35/ The University of Delhi issued a notification regarding UGCF 2022- Progression of students to Semester VII vide Notification No.- Acad.-I/NEP/UGCF/2025/194 on dated 01st May 2025. As per notification, the University of Delhi has implemented the National Education Policy (NEP 2020) at the Undergraduate level through Undergraduate Curriculum Framework 2022 (UGCF 2022) with effect from the Academic Session 2022-2023.

Further, the students enrolled under the UGCF 2022 shall be progressing to Semester VII in 4th Year of the respective Academic programmes being pursued by them with effect from the Academic Session 2025-2026. In this connection, it is highlighted that the progression of a student enrolled under UGCF 2022 from Semester VI to Semester VII is universal, subject to the promotion rules as applicable from time to time, and not restrictive in any manner whatsoever.

In addition as per ODL Regulation-2020 Clause 4 (B) (ii) "A Higher Education Institution shall be eligible to offer only those degree programmes at undergraduate and post-graduate levels and post-graduate diploma programmes, which it has already been offering in conventional mode of classroom teaching."

Further, as per Clause 4 (A) (V) " the entry level qualifications, curriculum, teaching-learning scheme, pattern of question papers for end semester examination or term end examination, pass or fails criteria in Dual Mode University are the same for conventional programme and the proposed Open and Distance Learning Programme or Online Programme, as applicable.

Therefore, as per ODL Regulation-2020 Clause 4 (a) (v) and 4 (B) (ii) the School of Open Learning, Campus of Open Learning, University of Delhi also adopted NEP-2020 with UGCF-2022 in the Academic session -2022 and onwards.

The Executive Council considered the report of the Internal Complaints Committee (ICC) vide letter No. ICC/DU/2024/132 dated 23.12.2024 on the complaint dated 18.05.2024 of Prof. D. Uma Devi, Department of Modern Indian Languages and Literary Studies (Complainant) against Prof. G. Rajagopal, Department of Modern Indian Languages and Literary Studies, University of Delhi (Respondent).

In its report, the ICC has made the following recommendations and observations :-

Recommendations of the ICC :

Based on the statements of the Complainant and the witnesses, it is evident that the Respondent is not found guilty as per the Section 2(k)(i) and 2 (e) (ii) of the UGC Regulation, 2015. However, the conduct of the Respondent reflects lack of sensitization and hence, the ICC recommended that the Department of Modern Indian Languages and Literary Studies to organize a gender sensitization program and to make it compulsory for all the faculty members to attend it.

Observations of the ICC :

- (i) The ICC noted that although the behavior of the Respondent did not exhibit any sexual harassment and he is not found guilty of sexually harassing the Complainant, he should have not behaved in such a manner with the Complainant in any circumstances. Being Professors of this esteemed institution, the decorum must be always maintained and communication should be done in a polite, civil, and professional manner, unlike pointing fingers and shouting at each other.
- (ii) The Committee would also like to mention the ill effect of the hostility among the Tamil faculty that led to this heated exchange of words. As faculty in the same department the personal differences must be set aside for the smooth functioning of all activities in the department.
- (iii) W6's act of filming video during the ongoing meeting was a gross misconduct on his part, even when the Respondent was constantly asking W6 to not do it. It was clearly not consensual. Also, with so many faculty members being present during the meeting, who were eye witnesses of the incident, W6 should have not filmed a video, as he was not alone there, that a dire need of filming arose.
- (iv) W10, who was an ex-student of this department, mentioned that she had an access to the video filmed by W6 of the incident. The ICC condemns this, as students must not be involved in the matters of faculty members. This action did not communicate confidentiality on the part of the Tamil faculty in terms of dealing with official matters.
- (v) The HoD did not take into consideration the Complainant's complaint, which prompted her to file a complaint with the ICC. The Committee hopes that in future the department would take the grievances of their faculty members seriously and help them.

The Executive Council noted that the Complainant and the Respondent have not filed any Appeal, as per the provisions of SHWW (PPR) Act - 2013 and UGC Regulation - 2015. The Executive Council after deliberations resolved to accept the report of the ICC and its above recommendations and observations.


