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24-23/ The Council resolved that the matter of extension of span period from (N+2+1) to (N+2+1+1) as provisioned under amended Ordinance VIII of the Ordinances of the University because of change over from CBCS to UGCF be accepted.

Background:

- I. The matter pertains to span period for various academic programmes conducted by the University and its Colleges both at the undergraduate and postgraduate level. The matter has been discussed at an appropriate level and is being submitted accordingly for consideration.
- II. In this connection, it is submitted that following is the amended Ordinance VIII of the Ordinances of the University as per Executive Council Resolution No. 33-9 dated 29.10.2021 (Ref. Executive Council Resolution No. 11-4 dated 28.02.2017/ 07.03.2017)

Amended Ordinance VIII reads as under:

- (2) All those students admitted from the session 2016-2017 who for whatever reasons are not able to complete the programme within the normal period of the minimum duration prescribed for the programme may be allowed two years beyond the normal period to clear the backlog to be qualified for the degree. The general formula, therefore should be as follows:
 - a) Time Span=N+2 years for the completion of programme where N stands for the normal or minimum duration prescribed for completion of the programme.
 - b) In exceptional circumstances a further extension of one more year may be granted. The exceptional circumstances be spelt out clearly by the relevant statutory body concerned of the University.
 - c) During the extended period the student shall be considered as a ex-student and also not be eligible for ranking.
- III. It is relevant to mention here that the University has implemented the National Education Policy 2020 (NEP 2020) through Under Graduate Curriculum Framework 2022 (UGCF 2022) with effect from the academic session 2022-2023.
- IV. The University is going to implement NEP 2020 through Post Graduate Curriculum Framework 2025 (PGCF 2025) with effect from the academic session 2025-2026.
- V. As per provisions of the NEP 2020, a student is eligible for multiple exit and multiple entry. Further, there has been a shift from the curriculum framework, both at the Under Graduate and Post Graduate Level, from Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) to UGCF/ PGCF.
- VI. Such change of curriculum framework led to a situation where some students are unable to complete their studies within the span period prescribed under amended Ordinance VIII of the Ordinances of the University. It has been ascertained from the Council Branch that the Standing Committee (Students) has considered those matters which fall under the N + 2 + 1 Scheme as mentioned in the amended Ordinance VIII.

VII. The matter has been deliberated extensively on this backdrop in the larger interest of the students to facilitate them to complete their Under Graduate/ Post Graduate programmes under CBCS, as those students who have fallen short by one year in the twilight zone of CBCS will be able to take advantage of this measure of one additional year of span period.

VIII. In view of the position explained above, the above proposal of provision of 01 additional year of Span period for those students who pursued CBCS and amendment of the Clause 2 of amended Ordinance VIII of the Ordinances of the University may kindly be considered by the Academic Council.

Background:

The University is implementing the fourth year of the Undergraduate Programmes from the academic session 2025-26, wherein three tracks have been provided to the students for the first time at the UG level, namely – Dissertation, Academic Projects and Entrepreneurship. A draft guidelines has been prepared for the supervision of Dissertations, Academic Projects, and Entrepreneurship in the 4th Year of the UG Programmes in the Colleges of the University, as per UGCF 2022 read with UGC Regulations, 2018 (as amended from time to time). The same is reproduced below:

Guidelines for Supervising Dissertations, Academic Projects, and Entrepreneurship in the 4th Year of the UG Programmes in the Colleges of the University, as per UGCF 2022 read with UGC Regulations, 2018 (as amended from time to time)

1. Faculty Supervision

- a. All faculty members, with or without a Ph.D., are eligible to supervise students undertaking research, dissertations, or entrepreneurship projects.
- b. Supervisors should be allotted students based on the topic of the student and faculty expertise in the said area, as far as possible. Colleges may formulate an objective parameter for the purpose of allotment of students for supervision.
- c. An academican holding the qualification of Assistant Professor or an Industry Expert (for the entrepreneurship track), with a professional qualification, either within or outside the university system, may be appointed as a Co-supervisor.
- d. An Advisory Committee for Research (ACR) for every student shall be constituted in the manner as prescribed.

2. Student Allocation and Group Work

- a. A faculty member may supervise a maximum of 10 students, subject to the student-teacher ratio of the relevant programme. The Research Committee of the College (RCC) may decide to increase the number of students assigned to the supervisor with appropriate justification.
- b. Dissertation writing must be done by a student individually and not in groups.

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- c. Academic Projects may be conducted individually or in groups of 2–3 students, but in case of a group project, individual contributions must be explicitly defined and manifested in the output for the purpose of assessment.
- d. *Essentials for Entrepreneurship I and II* (Generic Electives) provide a foundation of understanding Entrepreneurship. Students opting for the entrepreneurship track should study these two GE's in the 4th Year, if not studied earlier.

3. Supervision and Progress Tracking

- a. Faculty supervisors must provide guidance at regular intervals to the student to meet the prescribed outcomes for Semesters VII and VIII.
- b. Student shall appear before the Advisory Committee for Research (ACR) once every month and make a presentation of the progress of his/her work for evaluation and further guidance. A Monthly Progress Report (MPR) for each student, endorsed by the Advisory Committee for Research (ACR), must be submitted to the Subject Research Committee (SRC) of the college.

A. Research Committee of College (RCC)

Each college should have a College Research Committee (RCC). The RCC shall comprise of the following:

- i. Principal of the College
- ii. Convenor of IQAC
- iii. Teacher in-charge of various disciplines in the college

B. Subject Research Committee (SRC)

Each college should have a Subject Research Committee (SRC). The SRC shall comprise of the following:

- i. Teacher in-charge
- ii. Two faculty members by rotation – one from those who have more than 10 years of teaching experience and the other from those who have less than 10 years of teaching experience

C. Advisory Committee for Research (ACR)

Advisory Committee for research (ACR) shall comprise of the following:

- i. Supervisor
- ii. One faculty member from the same discipline
- iii. One faculty member from different discipline from the same college/ other college/institute

4. Research Funding

Student research projects may be supported through a variety of funding mechanisms. These include:

- i. Institutional funding from the College Student Welfare Fund ('Research promotion and student internship' and 'Innovative Projects') and College Facilities and Services Charges ('Research activities').
- ii. Funding from industry through industry-academic collaborations
- iii. Corporate Social Responsibility (CSR) initiatives
- iv. Alumni contributions or other mechanisms established by the college.

Funding should be awarded based on merit of the proposals of the students. Students must submit well-justified proposals. A proforma may be developed for this purpose by the colleges. A proper utilization certificate (UC) should be submitted in accordance with the college norms, if funding is provisioned.

5. Quality Control and Research Repository

To maintain academic integrity and quality, every college must maintain a research repository in digital mode and, if required, in physical mode containing:

- i. Title of the research work
- ii. Abstract summarizing the study
- iii. Keywords relevant to the topic
- iv. Plagiarism report verifying originality
- v. Supervisor's remarks on the quality and process

Additionally:

- a. A central portal may be developed to annually upload top undergraduate research papers for wider visibility and academic exchange.
- b. Both students and supervisors would be jointly responsible for ensuring that submitted work is original and complies with plagiarism policies.

6. Faculty Orientation and Support

Faculty members involved in supervising student research must receive regular training. Colleges should organize Faculty Development Programs (FDPs) covering:

- a. Instruction on research methodology
- b. Use of data analysis tools
- c. Ethical practices in research supervision
- d. A guidance handbook should be provided, containing: Assessment rubrics; Research logbook templates; Ethical declaration forms

7. Student Research Preparation

To prepare students for their research journey, colleges are advised to conduct orientation sessions at the start of each semester, which include:

- a. Research ethics and academic honesty
- b. Proper citation practices
- c. University's anti-plagiarism protocols (Librarian may be involved)
- d. Training in the use of referencing tools

Power to remove difficulties

Notwithstanding anything contained above, the decision of the Vice Chancellor shall be final and binding with respect to any dispute or differences, arising out of the interpretation and implementation of these guidelines.

The Finance Committee in its meeting held on 24.6.2025 noted the order dated 04.11.2024 & 23.05.2025 of the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi arising out of W.P.(C) 1387/2020 and Cont. Case (C)220/2025 respectively filed by Professor Madan Mohan.

Hon'ble High Court vide order dated 04.11.2024 has directed to pay the interest on delayed payment of gratuity on statutory rate from 01.04.2018 to 13.10.2023 to the petitioner Prof. Madan Mohan. In compliance of the order, University of Delhi has released a sum of Rs.5,57,189/- to Prof. Madan Mohan towards interest on delayed gratuity taking into consideration of statutory GPF rate of interest as applicable from time to time for the period from 01.04.2018 to 13.10.2023.

However, Prof. Madan Mohan has filed the contempt petition vide Contempt Petition No. 220/2025 claiming that interest rate @10% is to be paid to him on the delayed payment of gratuity.

Hon'ble High Court of Delhi vide order dated 23.05.2025 has directed the University of Delhi to pay the rate of interest @10% per annum as notified by the Central Government on the delayed payment of gratuity to Prof. Madan Mohan.

Note: Prof. Madan Mohan joined the University on 6th November, 2006 covered under NPS and retired on 31.3.2018.

The Govt. of India did not extend the payment of gratuity to the employees who entered into the service on or after 1.1.2004 and covered under NPS. Later on, the UGC vide letter No. F.No.67-3/2021(CU) dated 13.1.2023 has forwarded the MoE letter No. F.15-2/2022-TC 16.12.2022 regarding applicability of Payment of Gratuity Act 1972 to educational institutions under the MoE. The same was placed/reported in the EC in its 1264th meeting held on 3rd Feb.,2023. Accordingly, after implementation of payment of gratuity to the employees covered under NPS, payment of gratuity has been released to Prof. Madan Mohan. The delay in release of gratuity to the said employee was purely administrative and beyond the control of the University.

In compliance of the Hon'ble High Court order dated 23.05.2025 and to avoid any contempt proceedings, the following total payment of gratuity including interest @10% thereof has been released to Prof. Madan Mohan:

27/- The Council considered and approved the proposal of the Advisory Council of BioNEST-UDSC (a bio-incubator being managed by the Department of Microbiology, University of Delhi since July 2020), made at its meeting held on 16-12-2023, to establish BioNEST-UDSC as a Section 8 company. Minutes of the meeting is placed at **Appendix-82**.

Background Note:

1. The Department of Microbiology, University of Delhi South Campus, has been successfully running a bio-incubator (BioNEST-UDSC) since July 2020. This bio-incubator, being funded by DBT-BIRAC has been running in project mode. Initially funded for three years, the project was granted a two-year extension till July 2025 and then further for another one year till July 2026. The process of applying for Phase-II of funding from BIRAC was initiated as a result, the future structure of BioNEST-UDSC needs to be considered. As per BIRAC mandate, it is recommended that BioNEST-UDSC be set up as either a Society or a Section 8 company (**Appendix-83**). This will enable the incubation centre to apply for government grants for further funding. The purpose of setting up BioNEST-UDSC as a Section 8 company (proposed name: BioNEST-UDSC—Association of Scientific and Technological Research Activities (BioNEST-UDSC-ASTRA)) is to foster an ecosystem that promotes entrepreneurship and creates an environment of self-employment in the are of Life Sciences, particularly in the fields of medical biotechnology and agri-industrial biotechnology. This company would serve as non-profit interface between the institutions of learning and research in the Delhi-NCR area and the biotech start-up sector. Through laboratory infrastructure, essential and high-end equipment, as well as mentorship, it is aimed to nurture young life science professionals from the University of Delhi and beyond, encouraging them to become job creators and to develop new technologies and products.

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2. The Proposal of the structure of BioNEST-UDSC was discussed at length at the meeting of the Advisory Council of BioNEST-UDSC held on 16-12-2023. The Council members noted that a Section 8 company structure would help BioNEST-UDSC gain greater credibility as a central government-approved establishment. It was felt that the structure of a Section 8 company was preferable as this would also qualify BioNEST-UDSC for grants and subsidies from the government, while a Society structure may not support this. The matter was also discussed with University officials and authorities. After lengthy discussions, the Advisory Council proposed that the BioNEST-UDSC Team work towards establishing BioNEST-UDSC as a Section 8 company.
3. The BioNEST-UDSC team thereafter obtained in-principle approval as under:
- (i) Setting in motion the procedures for establishing BioNEST-UDSC as a Section 8 company in South Campus
 - (ii) Registering the Office premises of this company as “Director’s Secretariat, University of Delhi South Campus, New Delhi – 110021”
 - (iii) Appointing the First Directors of the proposed company.
4. It was proposed that an initial investment amount of INR 15,00,000/- be made as Share Capital/Subscription amount (amount to be drawn from BioNEST-UDSC Corpus accumulated User Charges). For Share Capital of the company consisting of INR 15 Lakhs, comprising 1,50,000 equity shares @INR 10/- each, it was proposed and approved in-principle that the following be appointed as subscribers of the proposed company under Section 8 of the Company Act-2013:

a) Prof. Yogesh Singh Vice Chancellor, University of Delhi	1,49,999 shares
b) Shri Vikas Gupta Registrar, University of Delhi	01 share

- (i) The decision taken by the Vice-Chancellor in respect of the termination the services of Dr. S.P. Gupta, Ex-Officiating Principal, Kirori Mal College w.e.f. 08.04.2017 vide letter dated 29.11.2017.
- (ii) The subsequent appeal was filed by Dr. S. P. Gupta, in terms of Clause 9 to the Annexure to Ordinance XII of the Ordinances of the University, the Appeal Committee constituted by the Hon'ble Chancellor and the order/award dated 15.12.2022 was passed.
- (iii) Dr. S.P. Gupta challenged the order/award of Appeal Committee in the High Court of Delhi in 2023 by filing a petition under section 34 of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. O.M.P. (COMM 143/2023) challenging the constitution of Arbitral Committee, wherein the Hon'ble High Court passed a judgement as under, "The impugned award, rendered as it is by an Appeal Committee, unilaterally constituted by the Chancellor of the University without the consent of the petitioner, is illegal and a nullity ab initio. The impugned award is therefore set aside. The appeal stands allowed in the aforesaid terms."
- (iv) The Office of the Chancellor was informed about the orders/proceedings of the Hon'ble High Court dated 20.09.2024 regarding the constitution of Appeal Committee vide letter No. DU/124/LEGAL/HC-7790/2023/438 dated 16.12.2024. **(Appendix-100)**
- (v) Dr. S.P. Gupta, again filed Writ Petition, WPC No. 1835/2025 challenging his termination order dated 30.11.2017 and further praying for release of benefits. This writ petition was disposed of vide order/proceedings dated 07.05.2025 where, University of Delhi (Respondent No. 2) through its advocate submitted to the Court that "University agreed that the petitioners appeal against the order of the Disciplinary Authority dated 30.11.2017 may be placed before an Arbitral Committee constituted under Section 45 of the Delhi University Act 1922".
- (vi) The Hon'ble Court directed on 07.05.2025 in the WPC No. 1835/2025, the following steps to complete the process constituting Arbitral Tribunal within 4 weeks:
 - "2. Pursuant to this agreement, the Executive Council of the University, and the petitioner herein are permitted to nominate one member of the Arbitral Tribunal each within the period of four weeks.
 3. The provision provides for an "Umpire" appointed by the Visitor of the University, who is the President of India. The appointment of an umpire, in the context of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 ("the Act"), must be read as "Presiding Arbitrator".
 4. It is clearly understood that the nomination of the Presiding Arbitrator by the Visitor of the University amounts to two members of the Tribunal being appointed by the various organs of the University, and one member being appointed by the petitioner. Mr. Saini submits that the petitioner has no objection to such course of action, and will file a written waiver to the applicability of Section 12(5) of the Act, before the Arbitral Tribunal

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when it is constituted. After nomination of the arbitrator by the petitioner and the Executive Council of University, the University is directed to forward the matter to the Visitor for appointment of the Presiding Arbitrator in these terms.”

- (vii) Accordingly, Kirori Mal College was advised to seek from Dr. S.P. Gupta the name of the Arbitrator from his side. Dr. S.P. Gupta nominated Shri Om Prakash Saini, former District & Sessions Judge, Delhi as his nominated Arbitrator. (Appendix-101)
- (viii) In consultation with the College, Ms. Puja Kalra, Advocate has been nominated by the Vice-Chancellor as the Arbitrator for the University of Delhi. (Appendix-102)

The Council was apprised that the faculty members appointed on ad-hoc in the Colleges and Departments of the University and were paid the initial pay of the scale of pay for the post of Assistant Professor.

The Council also observed that such faculty members have put in 10-15 years of service before being appointed on permanent basis in the Colleges and Departments of the University in the recent recruitment drive started from 01.04.2022.


As per the provisions of UGC Regulations 2018, 4/5/6 years of service in Pay Level-10 is required for incumbents with Ph.D./M.Phil./PG to be promoted/placed in Pay Level-11.


Further for promotion/placement in Level-12, 5 years of service in Level-11 is required. As indicated earlier the ad-hoc faculty members have served their total period at the initial pay in pay Level-10, their service beyond 4/5/6 years can not be counted for promotion beyond Level-11.

The Executive Council also considered that under the provisions of UGC Regulations for Merit Promotion Scheme-1998 the promotion of faculty members from Lecturer to Sr. Lecturer to Reader/Lecturer (Selection Grade) and Professor was based on the number of years of service. During the currency of this scheme the total length of ad-hoc services of the individual teacher was considered for his/her promotion to the subsequent designation after permanent appointment.

The Executive Council considered the aforesaid issues and resolved to request the UGC to permit the University of Delhi to consider the promotion of its ad-hoc faculty members and similarly placed teacher including appointed on temporary basis after their permanent appointment by counting the total number of years served irrespective of the Pay Level in which the period was served for promotion under Career Advancement Scheme.
