With respect to finalizing the Seat Matrix for admissions to Postgraduate Programs for academic session 2025-26, the Committee was informed of the Judgement with respect to W.P.(C) 803/2022 dated 22.04.2024 wherein the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi has directed the University to:

Page 59, Para (iii) "The DU would ensure, henceforth, that allocation/allotment of PG seats in the petitioner-College is not disproportionate. Among other considerations, the DU may consider, in deciding on the number of PG seats to be allotted, the infrastructure available with the concerned College, and the number of UG Students in that course of study admitted in the College. These, however, are merely suggestions, and the DU is at liberty to adopt any objective criterion as it deems fit in that regard."

Page 59, Para (iv) "In order to avoid further heartburn on this score, the DU is directed to consider framing of an appropriate policy or appropriate guidelines, to govern allocation/allotment of seats in PG courses amongst various colleges."

The Committee deliberated on the following data:

- 1. The proportional comparison of Undergraduate and Postgraduate seats in some sample colleges.
- 2. The proportion of Postgraduates seats distribution in different Colleges and Departments.

The above was also submitted to the Hon'ble High Court of Delhi

The Committee also observed that:

- (a) Irrespective of the fact whether a student takes admission in a department or in a college, the conduct of teaching, evaluation work etc.is done only in the Departments of the University of Delhi. It is only due to the Federal structure of the University that the seats have been "distributed" amongst the Departments and the Colleges.
- (b) The role of Colleges in PG Programs is limited only to the processing of the applications which are received on their dashboard through a centralized common allocation portal.
- (c) 50% seats of each Program must be sanctioned to the respective department, while the rest of the 50% seats may be distributed among various Colleges (wherever applicable)
- (d) The distribution of seats in colleges may be done considering the infrastructure and other logistic aspects of the colleges.
 - After detail deliberations, it was decided that the seat matrix of academic year 2024-25 may be continued for the academic year 2025-26 (except otherwise stated in the Minutes)
 - It was also decided that since 50% admissions must be done in the departments, if in a Program (such as in M.A. Punjabi, M.A. Urdu, M.A. Persian, M.A. Arabic), the number of students admitted is less than 50% of the sanctioned strength, the students allocated in the Colleges will be transferred to the respective department. The students will be transferred as per the merit in their respective category. The fees of such students will be refunded after the closure of the postgraduate admissions.

<u>38-40-3/</u>Addition of Supernumerary Seats to Single Girl Child in Postgraduate Programs.

It was decided that 01 (One) seat in each Program will be reserved under the Supernumerary Quota for a single girl child.

47/- The Council took a serious note of the recent incidents happened at the University, where Deans-Faculty of Law and Faculty of Arts were heckled, misbehaved and held captive by the students. The Council condemned the action of the students and express its utmost reprehension for such unacceptable behaviour.

The Council resolved that strict action be taken by the University against the errant and authorized the Vice-Chancellor for same.

The Council took on record the Judgment of the Hon'ble High Court of New Delhi in W.P. (C) 7824/2017 & W.P. (C) 13538/2024 dated 11.11.2024 - Prashant Manchanda Vs. Union of India ORS and Minutes of the Committee under Chairmanship of Director, South Delhi Campus (Minutes of the Committee and Judgment of the Hon'ble High Court is enclosed at Appendix-79)

The Council noted the contents of para 22 of the Hon'ble High Court order dated 11.11.2024 as reproduced below:

22. A proposal regarding the change in the current pattern of DUSU elections is also hereby proposed to prevent defacement and the use of muscle and money power at the University level. This proposal may be sent to all different stakeholders (College Unions, DUSU, College Principals/ Heads of the Department/In-charge of the Centers/Head-Director of the Institutions) of the University for further debate and discussion and for possible adoption of this model in future. Following is the proposal:

"Centralized single tier DUSU election may be replaced by two tier DUSU elections whereby the Colleges/ Departments/ Centre/ Institutes may hold elections at their own level and the President of the college Union/Department Union/ Centre Union as well as the Central Councilors may be allowed to take part in Tier II election in which the DUSU office bearers may be elected (This was one of the Lyngdoh Recommendations in Clause 6.2.4.)."

A similar model is followed in the Internal Complaints Committee elections of the University."

The Council also noted that the Hon'ble High Court vide order dated 11.11.2024 recorded the following in para 7, 11, 12 & 13 as reproduced below:

- 7. This Court has also been assured by Mr. Rupal, learned counsel for the Delhi University that henceforth non-observance of Guidelines of this Court and Lyngdoh Committee, by concerned students or officials shall be dealt with strictly.
- 11. Since the students studying in Delhi University are young, this Court is of the view that they deserve a second chance. After all, the intent of the present proceeding is to reform and not punish the young and impressionable minds. In fact, the intent of the present proceedings is to ensure that the students and candidates understand that the University and public property belongs to public at large which these students, in particular, candidates who contest DUSU Elections hold in trust and enjoy/use for a limited period of time. It is the responsibility of the current batch of students to ensure that the next batch of students get to use the University and public infrastructure in good and clean condition.

- 12. Consequently, this Court accepts the undertaking given by learned counsel for the students, who have defaced public property and direct the University of Delhi to verify compliance with the said undertaking and file a status report along with report from the candidates within ten days with the Registry of this Court.
- 13. This Court hopes and trusts that the student community at large and the candidates who have contested this election as well as those students who plan to contest the elections in the future have received a clear message that the public and University infrastructure should be kept clean and not defaced or harmed in any manner.

The Council resolved that DUSU Advisor and Chief Election Officer, DUSU shall submit proposal for issuing guidelines on DUSU election for the approval of the Competent Authority. The Council authorized the Vice-Chancellor to take appropriate decision and report the same to the Executive Council.
