

MINUTES

A meeting of the Oversight Committee constituted by the Competent Authority was held on 23.03.2022 at 4.00 p.m. in the Finance Officer's Committee, University of Delhi. The following members were present in the meeting:

Dean, Faculty of Arts, Dean, Examinations, Dr. Savita Roy, Principal, Daulat Ram College and Prof. Poonam Verma, Principal, Shaheed Sukhdev College of Business Studies could not attend the meeting due to other preoccupations.

Joint Registrar (Academic), Assistant Registrar (Academic) and Section Officer (Academic-I) assisted the committee in its deliberations.

The Chairman welcomed the members of the committee.

The Committee considered the letter dated 24.02.2022 from the Head, Department of Finance and Business Economics in which it is mentioned, "the MBA (Business Economics) course requires students in the 3rd semester to study six subjects and work on a Research project which is considered a seventh subject/paper. The research project is continued and completed in the 4th semester. Hence, marks are given out of 200 for the Research Project at the end of 4th semester."

He has requested the Oversight Committee "to take this into consideration in the preparation/declaration of result for 3rd semester, MBA (Business Economics) students. Third semester result may be declared for 24 credits for this one time."

The Committee was apprised by Prof. Yamini Gupt, nominee of the Head, Department of Finance and Business Economics, that previously i.e. before implementation of CBCS, the project work was carried out during the whole of final year (3rd and 4th semester) and being evaluated at the end of 4th semester till the implementation of the CBCS LOCF. Prof. Gupt has also provided the minutes of the Departmental Committee held on 21.04.2015, in which it was decided that the "Project Work" would be carried out taking into consideration the whole of final year (3rd and 4th semester). Subsequently, the results of the students were also declared by the Examination Branch.

The Committee discussed the Revised Programme Structure for MBA (Business Economics) under Choice-based credit system (CBCS) LOCF in which Masters Dissertation is of 4 credits in the 3rd and 4th semester each. However, the Department did not evaluate the students of the 3rd Semester for the Masters dissertation and the Examination Office is not a position to declare the result for want of the outcome of the evaluation of the Masters dissertation as informed by the OSD (Examinations), a member of the Committee.

The Committee took note of the facts placed before it by the Head, Department of Finance and Business Economics, input of the Special Invitee (nominee of HoD) and the OSD (Examinations) and deliberated upon the issue at length taking into consideration the interest of the students who have already taken this examination and would be adversely affected in case the results are not declared on time by the Examination Branch.

Taking into consideration the above facts and peculiar circumstances which has arisen due to non-evaluation of the Masters dissertation by the Department, the Committee recommends that the result of the 3rd semester may be declared without taking into consideration the Masters dissertation, as has been done earlier, to facilitate teaching learning in the 4th semester as per schedule, subject to the condition that the Department makes adequate amendment in the course structure/evaluation plan immediately through prescribed procedure before the 4th semester examinations begins, to set right the anomaly created in this process. The recommendation of the Committee for declaration of result of the 3rd semester is a one-time measure in the interest of the students only.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.
