- 4. The Department fulfills the required conditions of teaching faculty as per National Medical Commission. The Department is having 04 full time Professor, 02 Associate Professors for imparting of DM (Gastroenterology) Course.

5. The Clinical facilities in Gastroenterology department -

- Provides services for gastroenterology in out patient and in patient form.
- 56 dedicated beds for department including 8 ICU beds.
- About 12000 endoscopies, 2000 colonoscopies, 2000 ERCPs, 600
 EUS and 100 manometry annually..
- OTs and ICUs are well-stocked with upgraded surgical and anaesthesia equipment; adequate supportive services present.
- This infrastructure is sufficient to fulfil the demand of having 6 DM seats per year.
- Total no of OPD, IPD in the concerned departments: 70000 (2300)
- Gastroenterology spectrum includes all benign and malignant diseases with all therapeutic procedures done
- Adequate staff (nurses, technicians, orderlies, clerical, sanitation workers).
- 6. It was noted that the GIPMER has already obtained necessary approval of National Medical Commission /Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, Government of India for increase seats from 03 to 06 per year in DM (Gastroenterology) Course from academic year 2021 (Annexure – I)

B. SUGGESTIONS

- (a) The teachers should apply for recognition as DM (Gastroenterology) teachers with the University of Delhi.
- (b) The authorities of G.B. Pant Hospital will obtain necessary permission of the concerned Regulatory Bodies, wherever required as per rules of the National Medical Commission/Ministry of Health & Family Welfare.
- (c) The permission of Regulatory Bodies (Atomic Energy Regulatory Board) shall be obtained, if necessary.
