COURSE NAME: INTRODUCTION TO BUDDHIST LITERATURE

Objective

The primary objective of this course is to make students aware of the Indian languages (Pali and Buddhist Hybrid Sanskrit) in which the Buddhist literature including the biographical texts exists.

Learning of this course would make the students acquainted with the origin and development of the original language in which the Buddha disseminated his teachings in addition to developing a clear understanding among the students about the subsequently composed Buddhist literature in Sanskrit language.
